

# THE PRELUDE 2018: ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> AUGUST 2018

Gitarattan International Business School organized Orientation Programme, “**The Prelude**” for the newly enrolled students of undergraduate programmes (BBA, BALLB and BBALLB) on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 and for postgraduate programmes (MBA and MBA-IB) on 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2018. The objective of this event is to acquaint fresh batch of students with systems and processes that the Institute follows in conducting various programmes.

The Orientation Programme was conducted in two parts, viz., (a) General Orientation and (b) Programme wise Orientation.

On both days, the event started with lamp lighting and Ganesh Vandana and address by Shri Anirudh Jindal, Vice Chairman. The Vice Chairman emphasized on self belief and respect to be given to parents and teachers. He assured the students that best facilities and support shall be provided during their stay at the Institute.



## **Part-1: General Orientation**

During the General Orientation, students were briefed about the organisational structure of the Institute; academic administration system in vogue; broad academic calendar of odd semester; examination, evaluation & grading system adopted by the University; fee structure of each programme; facilities provided to students in terms of library, book-bank, computer centre etc. Students were encouraged to participate in various co-curricular, cultural and sports activities conducted by the Institute. Students were briefed about the anti-ragging measures; reporting system for prevention of sexual harassment of female students; grievance redressal system; SC & ST Cell and various rules regarding conduct and behaviour etc.

Institute-Industry Partnership Cell (IIPC) gave presentation on placement support provided to the students by the IIPC.

Dr Uma Gulati gave presentation to undergraduate programmes on 1<sup>st</sup> August and Prof Anup Kumar Gosh to postgraduate programmes on 2<sup>nd</sup> August.

On both the days, Prof S. Chaturvedi, Director General, addressed the students on aspects such self management, time management and path to develop as professionals.

## **Part-2: Programme -Wise Orientation**

In Part-2 of Orientation Programme, on both days, students were briefed by the respective Programme Coordinators and Class Coordinators about the course structure, time table, Schedule of classes etc. At the end, faculty members of the concerned programme/class were introduced.
