

INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO AIR CARGO TERMINAL, INDIRA GANDHI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, NEW DELHI ON 31ST OCTOBER, 2018

Gitarattan International Business School, Rohini, Delhi organized an industrial visit to the Air Cargo Terminal of IGI, New Delhi on 31st October, 2018 for the students of MBA(International Business)-First Semester.

The purpose of this visit was to make students understand complete learning of Export-Import process & procedure with reference to Air Cargo governed by the Delhi Customs Department. All the ground work and cargo handling processes are being managed by the Celebi, a Turkish Firm, called the Custodian of Cargo.

Students also understood practical aspects of logistics and supply chain management system of imports of cargo by Air.

In a nutshell, the whole process of imports of cargo by air involves around following steps:

1. Receipt of cargo and checking of documents related to the cargo.
2. Segregation of cargo based on general, perishable and precious one.
3. Inspection of cargo in the presence of authorized representative of importer.
4. Clearance by the Custom authorities.
5. Issue of cargo to the importing agency in least possible time.
