EVENTS GUIDE: ZENITH 2019

DAY 1: 16th FEBRUARY 2019 (SATURDAY)

EVENT-1

KUCH COOK KARE (COOKING WITHOUT FLAME)

Time: 10:00 A.M. - 11:30 A.M.

FOR KUCH COOK KARE:

1. In this event, each team is to prepare two items-one drink and one salad /snacks.
2. Team size shall be of 2 participants.
3. Participants are required to bring their own raw material (fully/partially cooked material are not allowed).
4. Participants should bring their own cutleries.
5. No provision for stove/oven will be given. Use of flame is not allowed.
6. Alcoholic items are not allowed.
7. Participants will be judged based on taste and presentation.
8. Top two teams will be awarded.
9. Judgments by the judges will be final and binding to all parties.

EVENT-2

TWIST-N-TURN (SOLO DANCE)

Time: 11.00AM -01.00 PM

FOR TWIST-N-TURN:

1. Participant will have to bring their song in CD or pen - drive.
2. CD's should be properly tagged with the song name, participant name.
3. The type of props to be used during performance should be informed earlier. Props related to fire are prohibited.
4. Judgment will be based on performance, costumes, expressions and song selection.
5. Time limit: 4-5 minutes.

EVENT-3

EK MINUTE KA KHEL (MINUTE TO WIN IT)

Time: 11.30 AM-12.30 PM

FOR EK MINUTE KA KHEL:

1. You've got a Minute to Win It.
2. The game will feature participants competing in 60-second challenges with objects for a shot at amazing prizes.
3. In this event the participants are to complete the small challenges such as put a thread in the needle, defying gravity, baby blocking game etc. in a minute.
4. There will be one game to be played. The player who will complete the game in minimum time will be the winner.
5. There should not be any discussions or use of unfair means.
6. Individual players have to show their points to the event coordinator.
7. Maximum number of participation is restricted to 30.

EVENT-4

FACE PAINTING

Time: 11.30 AM-1.00 PM

FOR FACE PAINTINGS:

1. Theme will be given on the spot.
2. In this event, one team member is to make painting on the face of other team member on a given theme.
3. Teams can consist of maximum 3 members, out of which 2 members can paint.
4. Painting is to be done by brushes, paints and sponge. Candidates have to carry their own material.
5. The painting should not extend below the neck (however neck may be included).
6. Time Limit: 45 minutes.
7. No external help like internet is allowed during the event

EVENT-5

NUKKAD NAATAK (STREET PLAY)

Time: 12.00 PM-2.00 PM

FOR NUKKAD NAATAK:

1. Time limit: 15 minutes.
2. Play should be in Hindi only.
3. Number of participants per team is restricted to 25.
4. Play should revolve around social cause or convey any social message.
5. Each member of a team should perform in the act.
6. Negative marking shall be done if play exceeds time limit.

EVENT-6

GEET GAATA HOON MAIN (SOLO SINGING)

Time: 12.30PM -02.00 PM

FOR GEET GAATA HOON MAIN:

1. The time limit is 2-3 minutes.
2. Participant will have to sing a single song. Medley of songs will not be allowed.
3. Participants will have to bring their own karaoke or instrument
4. An instrumentalist can accompany a vocalist.
5. Judgment will be based on talent, rhythm, voice quality and performance

EVENT-7

BATTLE OF BANDS

Time: 2.00 PM - 4.00 PM

FOR BATTLE OF BANDS:

1. For the purpose of this competition band is defined as three or more people with at least two people playing a musical instrument.
2. "The Battle of the Bands" performers must play 4 songs.
3. All the members of the band must be from same college/institute.
4. Performers must submit a one-song demo video/copy of lyrics in order to qualify for the contest. Originals are encouraged!
5. Lyrics cannot include profanity, derogatory remarks, sexually explicit content or violence.
6. The removal of clothing and the use of obscene language and gesture are prohibited and will result in the band being disqualified and escorted from the building.
7. For every minute exceeding the 10 minute limit, the band will be penalized 5 points from their total score.
8. Bands will have 15-20 minutes to set up, perform and disband. Any band that goes over the allotted time will have points deducted.
9. A panel of judges will score musicians on a point system. Judging criteria includes technical proficiency, musicality, performance, creativity and audience reaction.

NOTE: Participation and performance sequence for all group events shall be decided on the spot by lottery system. Change of schedule will not be accepted.

DAY 2: 17th FEBRUARY 2019 (SUNDAY)

EVENT-1

THE TREASURE HUNT (KHUL JA SIM SIM)

Time: 10:00A.M. - 11.00A.M.

FOR THE TREASURE HUNT:

1. Duration of the event: 01 hour. Only one team is allowed per college. 02 participants per team.
2. Maximum 10 teams will be registered on FIRST CUM FIRST SERVE BASIS.
3. Clues will be hidden, which have to be found and treasure is to be found in the shortest time.
4. Point value will be assigned for each clue that is found during the treasure hunt.
5. Teams should pick up only one copy of the clue at each location.
6. If any team that tries to physically obstruct the hunt for the other teams, it would be disqualified.
7. Outside help is not permitted during the treasure hunt.

EVENT-2

LAN-E-JUNG (LAN GAMING)

Time: 10:00 A.M. - 11:30 A.M.

FOR LAN-E- JUNG:

1. There will be one game to be played. Participants are to play a Videogame- 'Counter Strike.
2. There should not be any discussions or use of unfair means.
3. Teams have to show their points to the event coordinator.
4. One team shall have 5 players.
5. Total number of rounds will be 10 (02 minutes each).

EVENT-3

BEST OUT OF WASTE

Time: 11:00 A. M. - 12:00 P.M.

FOR THE BSET OUT OF WASTE:

1. A team should consist of minimum 2 members & maximum 3 members
2. Only waste material should be used. Other stationary things like fevicol, scissors, stapler, tape etc. Is allowed..
3. The participants need to bring their own waste material. But use of partial, whole or readymade model and any other unfair means will directly lead to disqualification.
4. The recycled products should be useful.
5. Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

EVENT-4

TAAL-SE-TAAL MILA (GROUP DANCE)

Time: 11.00 AM -1.00 PM

FOR GROUP DANCE:

1. All dance forms are allowed.
2. CD's should be properly tagged with the song name, participant name.
3. Time limit for the performance should be 8-10 minutes. In case of exceeding the time limit, negative marking will take place.
4. The team should be of 15-20 members.
5. Participants will be judged on the basis of dancing style, coordination, costume, expressions and choreography.
6. Teams have to bring their own props and costume.
7. Teams have to report 02 hours before the event time.
8. Sequence of performance will be done through lottery method at 11:00AM.

EVENT-5

MONO ACTING

Time: 11.30A.M. - 1:30 P.M.

FOR THE MONO ACTING:

1. The act should be in Hindustani (Hindi/English) language.
2. The duration of the act must be for maximum 5-8 minutes along with setting up of stage.
3. Participants may mimic sound of machines and speeches of well-known persons including SAYERS (can use shayari while Mono-Acting) etc. Including film personalities.
4. On the other hand for mono acting judgment is based on qualities like idea, creativity of presentation, use of makeup, music & general impression. Marking will be based on Skill imitating, Presentation Variety of sound and voices imitated.
5. No vulgarity- In word or action.
6. No political comments.
7. No religious remarks will be entertained.
8. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable

EVENT-6

RANGOLI

Time: 11.30 AM-1.00 PM

FOR RANGOLI:

1. Theme will be given on the spot.
2. Two members in every team.
3. Time limit is of 1.5 hours.
4. Use of flowers, colors, etc is allowed.
5. Designing should be done on the spot.
6. Disqualification is possible if found cheating.
7. Places for rangoli making will be allotted then and there.
8. Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
9. Use of any electronic device is strictly prohibited.

EVENT-7

ZENITH FASHION MANIA (MR. & MS. ZENITH)

Time: 1.30 PM-3.30 PM

FOR ZENITH FASHION MANIA:

1. Maximum number of participants: 10 each for Mr. & Ms. Zenith.
