

VISIT TO THE PARLIAMENT NEW DELHI

26th MARCH 2019

Gitarattan International Business School organised a visit to the Parliament, New Delhi for the IVth Semester Students pursuing BA LLB programme on 26th March, 2019. With due permission a team of 58 students visited the Parliament house.



Firstly the students visited the Lok Sabha House of the Parliament and sat in the public gallery of the House. The Seats and Carpet of the Lok Sabha are green in colour which denotes that the elected members of the House are from grass root level. Therefore, The Lok Sabha is also known as the Lower House or the House of the People. The staff of Parliament briefed the visitors about the sitting arrangement of the elected members of the Lok Sabha. The House has a seating accommodation for 550 Members. The seats on the right-hand side of the Speaker's Chair are reserved for the Members of the ruling party and seats on the left-hand side for Members of the opposition party.

In the next, the students visited the Rajya Sabha. The seats and carpet of the Rajya Sabha are red in colour which signifies royalty and the sacrifice done by our freedom fighters for the independence of India. The Rajya Sabha is also known as the Upper House. The House has a seating capacity for 250 members. This house is a permanent house and cannot be dissolved.

After Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha the guiding staff took the students to the Central hall. The hall is the place where the President of India addresses joint session of both the houses. The oath of President of India and the chief Justice of India takes place in Central Hall only. The Indian Constitution was also framed in the Central Hall which has fans that stood on stands which rise up from the ground instead of ceiling fans.

This educational trip helped the students to observe and learn about the Temple of Democracy of India. It was really an enriching visit for the students.
