VISIT TO HON'BLE DISTRICT COURT, ROHINI

04 SEPTEMBER, 2019

Gitarattan International Business School organised a visit to District Court, Rohini for BBA LLB Semester I students, on 04th September, 2019. The objective of the visit was to inculcate respect for the legal profession, apprise the students with working of District Court and Court Decorum. Underlying objective of the visit was to provide exposure to the students at this nascent stage of their career and invoke in them a sense of social responsibility which they have towards society while pursuing *Law* as a profession. In addition to the above mentioned objectives this Court Visit also focused on making students aware about the working of the District Court.



The students were first made to visit Family Court, where a keen interest was shown by the presiding judge in briefing the students about the ongoing case, what are the documents filed by the parties, relevance of chief and cross examination were few aspects covered by her. Visit to Family Court was followed by witnessing Court proceedings in Metropolitan Magistrate's Court, NDPS Court (Special Court constituted Under Narcotic Drugs And Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985), and Mediation Centre as well. An interactive session took place between Sunil Kumar Sharma (Administrative Civil Judge cum Additional Rent Controller North West) where students were sensitised on how they are obligated to uphold the Court Decorum as well as the benefits of starting a career in field of litigation. The key outcome of this Court visit was the realization on part of the students about the importance of mediation in settling the disputes and mannerism of addressing the judges in the court. In addition to this, the entire visit has substantially prepared students for their upcoming internship.
