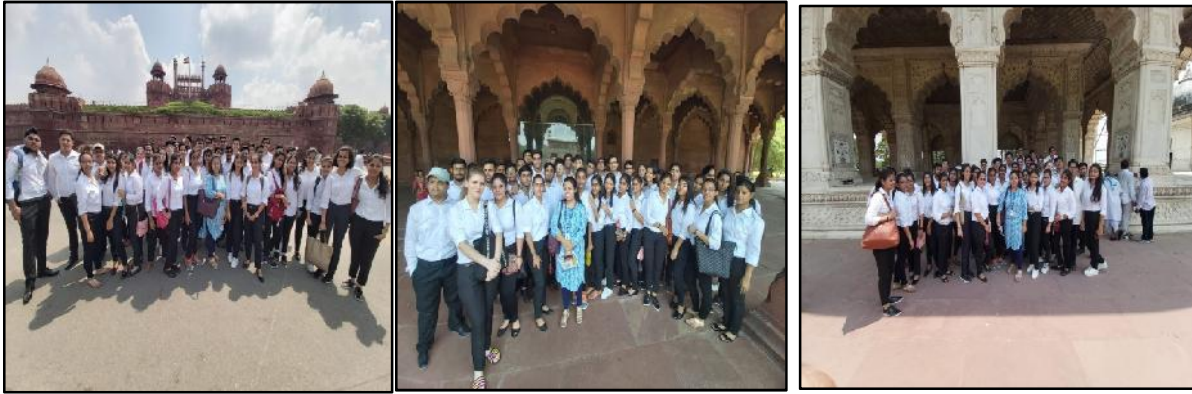


# EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO HISTORICAL MONUMENT

## RED FORT

### 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2019

Gitarattan International Business School organised an educational visit to a historical monument, the Red Fort in Delhi for Law students of class BA LLB semester I on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.



A group of 45 students along with one faculty member visited the Red Fort. The objective of the trip was to develop sense of history among the students. The Red Fort also known as Lal Quila stands on the bank of river Yamuna. Emperor Shah Jahan commissioned the construction of Red fort on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 1638 when he decided to shift his capital from Agra to Delhi, it got completed on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 1648. The architect of the Red Fort was Ustad Ahmad Lahori. It is built using red sand stone and white marble. Students could see the layouts of Mughal period courts called 'Diwan-e-Aam' and 'Diwan-e-Khas' and other structures like Chhatta Chowk, Naubat Khana , Rang Mahal and Hammam. Intricate inlay work is done on the walls of the structure.

The trip was really an unforgettable experience for the students which apart from being intellectually rewarding, gave them a glimpse of our country's proud history and culture.
