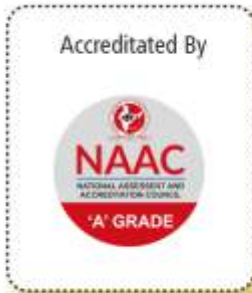

Law Programmes @ CLS-GIBS

BBALLB(Integrated)

Bachelor of Business Administration & Bachelor of Legislative Law (BA LLB) is a Five Year integrated undergraduate programme designed for 10+2 pass aspirants to acquire legal degree and become law professionals. As part of a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) LLB course aspirants are first taught Commerce subjects such as Principles of Management, Financial Accounting, Computer Applications, Effective Communication, etc. Thereafter, aspirants are taught law subjects such as Law of Torts, Family Law, Constitutional Law, Property Law, Company Law, Administrative Law, Civil Law, Criminal Law, and the likes.

BALLB(Integrated)

The Bachelor of Arts - Bachelor of Legislative Law (BA LLB) course is a five year integrated law degree for 10+2 pass aspirants to acquire legal degree and become law professionals. The law degree is an integration of Arts and Law subjects. Therefore, as part of the BA LLB course, the candidates study subjects including Economics, History, Political Science, Sociology along with law subjects like Civil Law, Criminal Law, Labour Law, Tax Law, Administrative Law, Corporate Law, Patent Law etc. Moreover, candidates are taught about law case studies, moot courts, law internships, seminars and interactions with retired judges from Hon'ble High Courts and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Holistic Growth of the Students

Exclusive Skill Based

Training Programmes (SBT)

to make students 'Job Ready'

Skill is an essential component for any law professional to showcase his / her personality in demonstrative mode. With an aim to make the student groomed under the broad Skill India guideline, Skill Based Training (SBT) is conducted under two heads: **Hard Skills Training and Soft Skill Training.**

Under Hard Skills Training, students are trained in two essential skills needed by every law professional viz.,

- **Legal Research Skill**
- **Legal Drafting Skill**

SBT on Legal Research is conducted in 6th Semester. The process of searching and locating relevant legal information is a challenging endeavour for any researcher. Lawyers, legal secretaries, law librarians, paralegals, law students, and journalists alike must be able to comb through the near-endless supply of legal research and find the information they need in a timely fashion. After pursuing SBT on Legal Research, the students are expected to view the written work of judges, law professors, and colleagues, in addition to public records and other business information, which aids them when making predictions about the direction of changes in the law and also to acquire the ability to carry out quick, comprehensive and focused research with deadlines.

SBT on Legal Drafting is conducted in 8th Semester. Formation of legal documents is the integral part to practice law and possessing good drafting skills is crucial for every lawyer. This course on legal drafting is precisely developed to teach our student to draft various types of legal documents. Drafting of each document is taught along with related practical and theoretical aspects.

Under Soft Skills Training, students are trained in two essential areas viz.,

- **Personality Enhancement**
- **Pre-Placement Training**

SBT on Personality Enhancement starts from the first semester itself. Living in a society where people are first judged on the basis of their personality and skills later, Personality Enhancement Workshops are integrated with the course delivery as the first step towards building lawyers for tomorrow. Internationally acclaimed personality enhancement trainers conduct these workshops for the students.

Pre-Placement Training is carried out for a duration of 1-2 weeks before actual placement to ensure that the students are job ready. Workshops are conducted for them on various skill-building exercises, such as CV Writing, Mock Interviews, Group Discussions, Tips on cracking an interview etc.



THE CAMPUS

To make the students follow the changing trends of latest technology, the campus is meticulously designed, and the institute provides a professionally motivating atmosphere of learning and development. The college building is spacious, well-ventilated, lighted and there are enough open spaces around the building.

GIBS offers a safe and accessible location. The Campus is just 50 meters distance from the Delhi Metro, Pitampura and Rohini East, being the nearest metro stations. Industry Institute Placement Cell (IIPC)

The Industry Institute Placement Cell (IIPC) at GIBS endeavours to provide internship opportunities across all batches and final placement to final year students in the field of law. The aspirants are placed with the best law firms, advocates and corporations for internship and for post placement offers. IIPC is the only authorized body to formally approach and communicate with the recruiters in relation to any recruitment/internship process. It is the responsibility of this Cell to keep the students informed about best offers which benefit them in their areas of interest. However the students are free to approach any law firm, corporation or advocate for internship/placement duly informing the IIPC. Various grooming activities and career counselling sessions along with the training sessions are conducted regularly for their overall professional development. The Cell is headed by a faculty member supervising student volunteers who work enthusiastically throughout the year under their guidance for networking and relationship building with prospective employers. The Cell provides assistance to not only those who aspires to be recruited by firms but also to those who wish to establish their own venture by providing them necessary guidance.

Activities undertaken by the IIPC



1. The role of IIPC(Industry Institute Partnership Cell)is of a facilitator for placement related activities. IIPC does not guarantee a job.
2. The Cell shall endeavor to secure placements for the final year students of law, through arrangement of placement interviews, campus recruitments and direct recruitments and internships across all batches.
3. The Placement facility is available to all the students registered with IIPC through the policy one job to one student at in the first instance. This will ensure that every student will get equal job opportunities and only few students do not consume up all the jobs.
4. It is the responsibility of this Cell to keep the students informed about best offers which benefit them in their areas of interest through emails, messages and placement channel on MS-Teams.
5. IIPC is the only authorized body to formally approach and communicate with the recruiters in relation to any internship/ recruitment process.
6. However, the students are free to approach any law firm, corporation or advocate for internship/ placements duly informing the IIPC, CLS- GIBS.
7. In case any student still remains unplaced after appearing for 13 companies offered by IIPC, further opportunities will be given only after other students are successfully placed.
8. Once a placement offer has been made to a candidate, he/she will be deemed to be placed. So that will lead to automatic withdrawal from the campus recruitment process.
9. Students cannot drop out from selection process once he/she has been shortlisted. A disciplinary action will be taken against defaulter students.

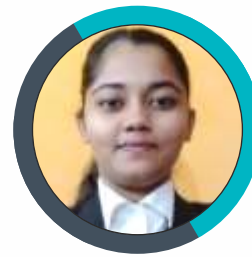
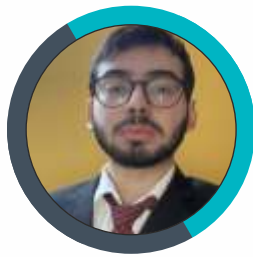
