

REPORT ON E-FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

(6th July, 2020-18th July, 2020)

Gitarattan International Business School organized E-Faculty Development Programme on the theme of “Preparedness towards Post Pandemic: Teaching, Learning and Research” from 6th July, 2020 to 18th July, 2020. The two weeks long programme was designed to enrich the knowledge of the faculty members on new ways of doing teaching and research. The new paradigm of teaching is blended form of learning in, which there is judicious mix of physical and virtual classes.



On 6th & 8th July, 2020 Prof. B.L Gupta, Professor, NITTR, Bhopal conducted sessions on project based learning and research based learning respectively. In his deliberations the emphasis was laid on the project work and research as the pedagogical tools to incite higher form of learning among the students. He recommended that as per the NBA (National Board of Accreditation) faculty members in higher educational institutes should work as per the Bloom’s

Taxonomy and try to imbibe higher form of learning in the students. On 7th July, 2020, Lieut (Retd.) Rita Gangwani addressed the participants on managing work-life balance during the present times. Participants responded enthusiastically and asked many questions from the resource person and Lieut.(Retd) delighted participants with her responses. On 9th July, 2020 Mr. Sukrit Ghosh took the session on the “assessment techniques in the virtual environment”. His focus was on tools in digital platform for the formative and summative assessments of the students. On 10th and 11th July, session on Time series analysis was conducted using the platform of E-views by Dr. Sunita Arora. Her impeccable delivery and vast knowledge created huge interest among the participants. Her two days session was on Multiple Time Series Regression with E-views and ARDL and VECM.

On 13th and 14th July Dr. Ajay Chouhan, founder of Research Shiksha.com conducted sessions on qualitative analysis using Nvivo. He detailed on how faculty members and researchers can utilize secondary data for generating insights. He further conducted hands-on using social media with the participants on the platform of Nvivo. On 15 and 16th July, Dr. Runa Maitra did her sessions on Group Discussion using Blended form of learning. It is important for the faculty to learn to incorporate participative learning tools like Group discussion in their pedagogy. Her session was highly interactive and even participants made presentation as well.

On 17th & 18th July, Prof. K. Srinivas, head ICT and Project Management Unit of National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration, an Institute of Govt. of India under ministry of Human Resource Development. He spoke on the Government of India initiatives to make education digital. He detailed on the tools available for the synchronous and Asynchronous form of teaching in digital environment.
