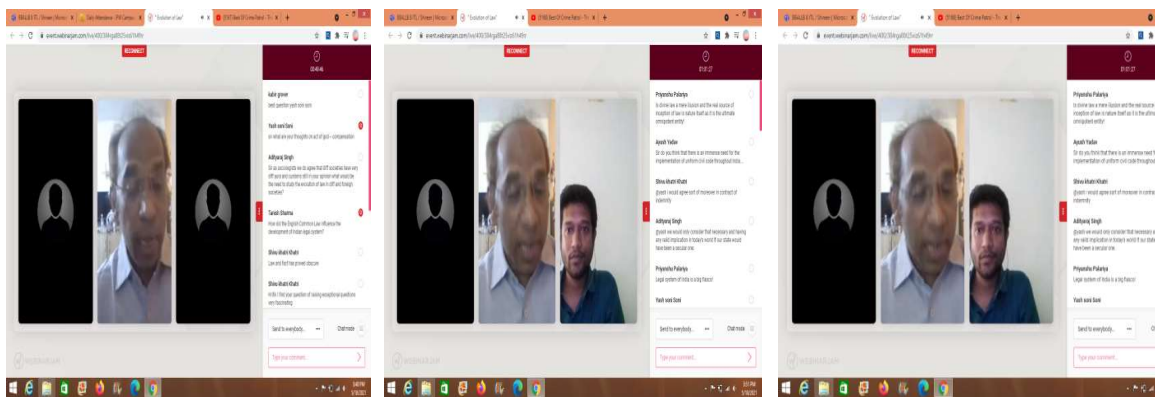


E JURIST DAY ON EVOLUTION OF LAW 18th MAY 2021

The Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School, organized webinar on E-Jurist Day. The theme of the event was “EVOLUTION OF LAW “addressed to the students of BA LLB & BBA LLB Semester II. The eminent speaker for the event was Prof. Dr. Tapan R Mohanty, Professor (Sociology of Law/ Socio Legal Studies) National Law Institute University, Bhopal.



The aim of the webinar was to acquaint students with the origin of law and complexity surrounding its definition - **What is law? How does law define itself?** Prof. Mohanty started the session by describing the origin of law and listed different types of law like natural law, Divine law. He further explained how humans became civilized and people started paying obeisance to the laws made by kings. With the passage of time new system of governance developed and democracy came into existence. Democracy entailed new and developed system of justice, as a result modern day courts were established. He also mentioned the Jurisprudential aspect of law and a focused on different perspectives wherein the law can be an instrument of social transformation.

He emphasised the need to understand the different approaches used by eminent jurist while they define law and opined that such approaches are also used while shaping the civilization, country, governments, society as well as human conduct. He concluded the session by stating that law is evolving, evolution being a continuous process; law will grow and change with time.
