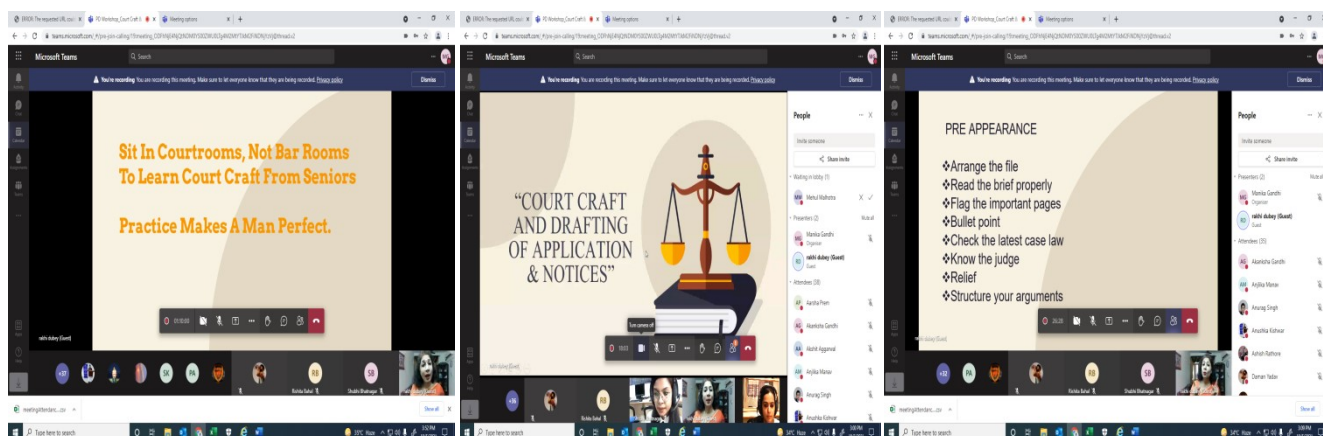


A PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

The Institute organized PD Workshop on “Court Craft & Drafting of Applications & Notices” for the students of BA and BBA Semester VII on 05th October, 2021.

Ms. Rakhi Dubey, Advocate in Supreme Court of India and Delhi High Court and a nominated Counsel in Delhi High Court for Tihar Jail and Rohini Jail as appointed by Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee chaired the session.
