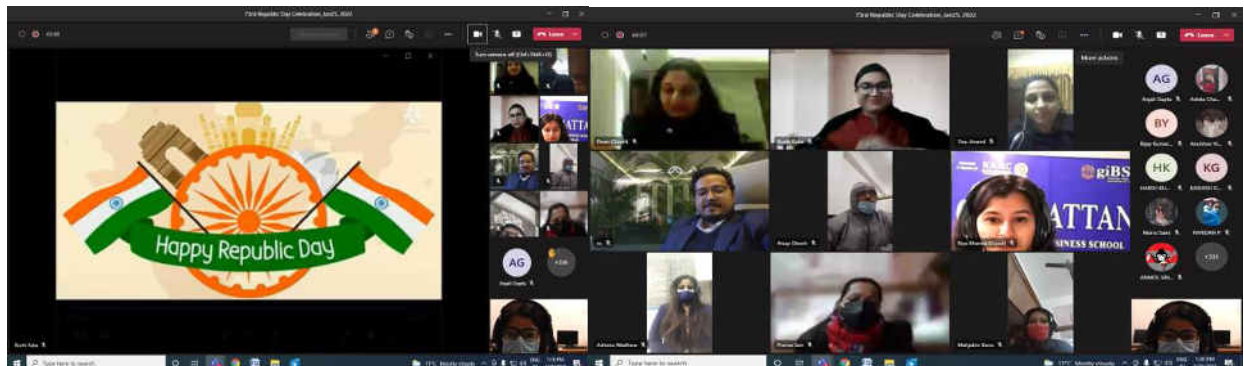


# REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

25<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2022

Gitarattan International Business School celebrated 73<sup>rd</sup> Republic Day on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2022 in the college premises.
