

**PANEL DISCUSSION ON
JUVENILE JUSTICE (CARE AND PROTECTION)
AMENDMENT ACT, 2021
27th FEBRUARY, 2022**



Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School organized a Panel Discussion on Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Amendment Act 2021 on 27 February, 2022.

The panelists were Hon'ble Justice Mahavir Singhal, Retd. Add. District Judge, Delhi, Hon'ble Justice Harvir Singh, District & Sessions Judge, and Prof. (Dr.) S.C. Raina, Former VC, HPNLU, Shimla.

Prof. (Dr.) M. Afzal Wani, Former Dean USLLS, GGSIPU was the moderator for the panel discussion.

The distinguished experts enlightened audience about Juvenile Delinquency. Hon'ble Justice Mahavir Singhal initiated the session by discussing the technical aspects of the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act wherein he highlighted the amended sections.

To put the amendments in perspective Hon'ble Justice Harvir Singh developed the historical background of the amended provisions. He focused on the differences between the provisions and their actual implementation. The lacuna in the amendment and its implementation as a matter of concern was also discussed.

Prof. (Dr.) S.C. Raina dealt with provisions related to adoptions as prescribed under the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act. He also recommended some relevant personal laws for inclusion in India Penal Code. Prof. (Dr.) M. Afzal Wani moderated the entire panel discussion with his valuable insights.

In the concluding remarks the moderator advised students to inculcate a comprehensive understanding of laws and come up with positive amendment solutions.
