

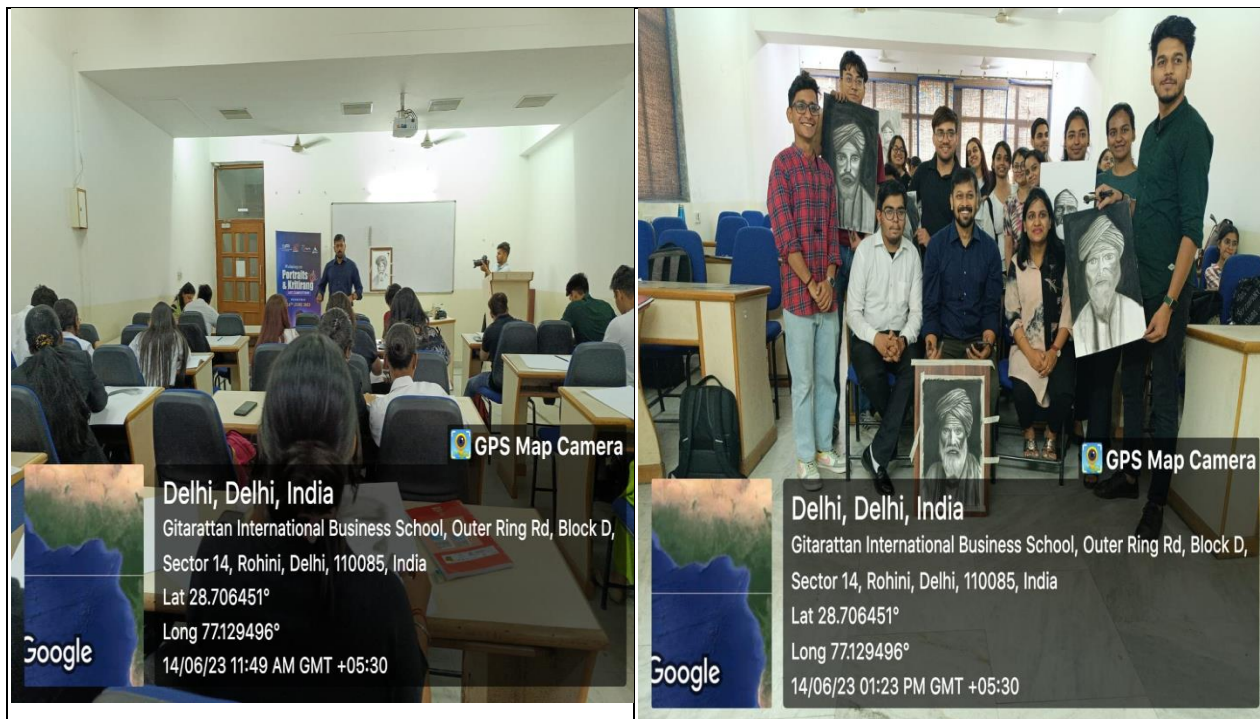
EXPRESSIONS – WORKSHOP ON PORTRAIT
