

ACADEMIC VISIT TO
“THE HON’BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA”

Gitarattan International Business School organized an Academic visit to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 18th April 2023 from 1:30PM onwards. The visit was organized for BALLB Eighth semester students to enhance the knowledge of their domain. The visit was organized for making the students aware of the functioning of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The key aim behind arranging the trip was to boost the confidence of students by helping them attain Supreme Court-relevant knowledge, which would come to their aid in blooming into successful lawyers for filing Appeals. giBS strongly believe that providing the students with hands-on experience of live court proceedings can work wonders in instilling in them a sense of discipline and responsibility and also acquaint them with court etiquette. The students were instructed by the faculty coordinator about the Rules and the decorum to be maintained inside the Court Premises.

To observe the proceedings the causelist of 18th April 2023 was shared with the students for the reference of matters listed in the Court Rooms. The students were issued passes for different Court Rooms. The students therefore observed the hearing in the delegated Court Rooms. The students were guided by the Faculty Coordinator to how to go through the causelist, the etiquette to enter the court room and how to observe the parallel matters going on in the other Court Rooms.

The students got the opportunity to hear the arguments of Bilkis Bano Case i.e. Bilkis Yakub Rasool Vs Union of India and Ors , W.P.(Crl.) No. 491/2022 listed in Court No. 3 being presided by Hon'ble Mr. Justice K.M. Joseph and Hon'ble Mrs. Justice B.V. Nagarathnathe wherein Supreme Court had sought files on the premature release of convicts. The students got the opportunity to observe the arguments by Advocate Shobha Gupta, representing Bilkis Bano, the Additional Solicitor General SV Raju(Sr. Advocate) representing Union and State, Senior advocate Mr. AM Singhvi, appeared for the PIL petitioners, Senior advocate Mr. Siddharth Luthra, appeared for one of the convicts. The original record was not presented therefore the bench ordered all the respondents shall file their replies by May 1 and posted the matter for further hearing on May 2. The report was written by the students in the respective Courts allotted. The students got the opportunity to interact with Lok Sabha MP Ms. Mahua Moitra who was an appellant in one of the tagged matters of Bilkis Bano Case i.e. W.P.(Crl.) No. 000326 of 2022, Mahua Moitra vs. State of Gujarat. Students got the chance to visit the Judges Library wherein they were guided how the books are referred for a particular case to the Judges before the case hearing.
