

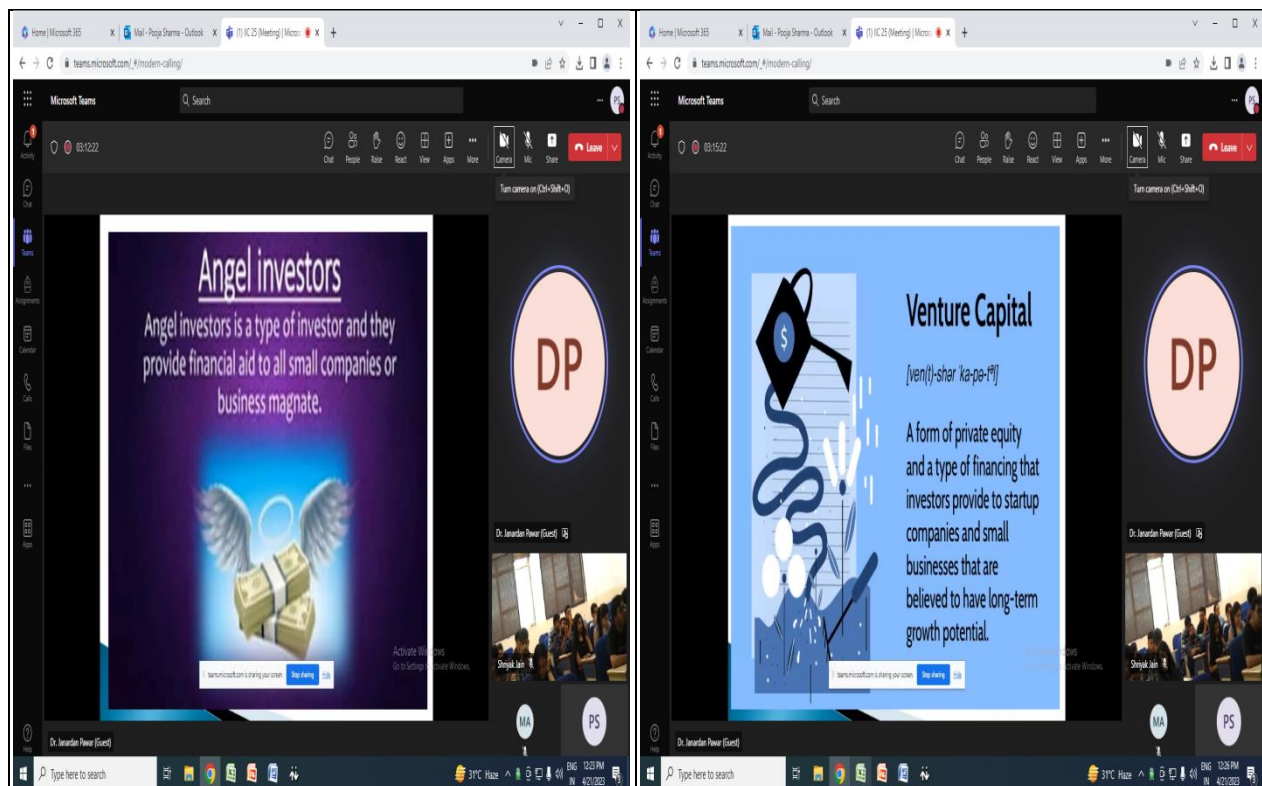
# IIC - Webinar on Angel Investment/ venture Capital finding opportunity for early-stage Entrepreneurship
