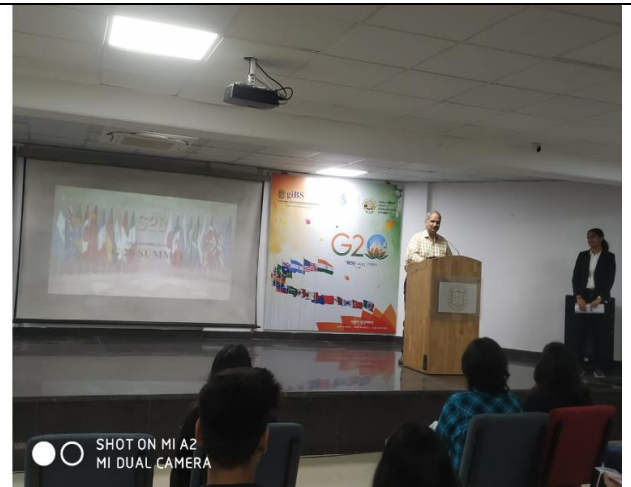
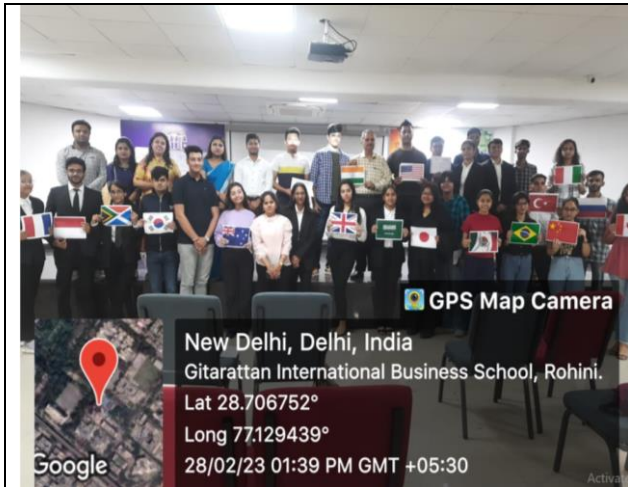


G20 QUIZ COMPETITION

India is honoured to hold the coveted G20 Forum Quiz Competition President from December 2022 to November 30th, 2023. "One Earth, One Family, One Future" is the motto of India's G20 Presidency. This is a strong affirmation of beliefs in shared and common solutions, drawing on our cultural ethos. 20 of the world's largest economies are represented by the G20. The G20 initially concentrated mostly on major macroeconomic issues, but it has subsequently broadened its agenda to include topics like climate change, sustainable development, health, agriculture, and anti-corruption.

Engaging young minds on important issues is the pivot of Gitarattan International Business School and with this aim, NSS unit of Gitarattan International Business School organized G20 Quiz competition for its students on 28th February 2023. 13 teams participated in the quiz competition. Quiz was conducted in four rounds which were named as Round 1- The History of G20 Summit: In this round, questions from the history of G20 summit were asked, Round 2-G-20 India's Presidency : In this round questions related to role of India in G20 summit were asked. Round 3- Identify the picture: In this round pictures related to G20 were displayed and the questions were asked. Round 4- Rapid Fire Round: In this round a set of questions were asked from each team and they had to give maximum correct answers within the time period of 40 seconds. The students were given a platform, and it even piqued their interest in global concerns from a financial standpoint.

All the participants were incredibly enthusiastic. The winner of the event was Team E- Saksham Sharma BBA 5th Sem. & Hiten Chadha BBA 5th Sem.
