**Emerging trends of family law: same sex marriage, live in relationship, succession**

Gitarattan International Business School, Delhi, Centre for Legal Studies, organized Jurist Day on “Emerging trends of family law: same sex marriage, live in relationship, succession” on 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 from 11:30-1:00PM at Seminar Hall. This session intended to make students aware of ‘Emerging Trends of family law: same sex marriage, surrogacy, live in relations, Succession-latest which is an emerging issue. Law students are budding future lawyers and will be contributing to the legal profession in every possible way. The key speaker of the session was Hon’ble Sh. Manmohan Sharma, District Judge, Director- Administration, Delhi Judicial Academy, Delhi.



The session began with the felicitation of the guest speaker Hon’ble Sh. Manmohan Sharma, District Judge, Delhi with the sapling by Hon’ble Director Prof. P.M Johari. Hon’ble Sh. Manmohan Sharma started the session by discussing that the Family law is a branch of law that regulates family matters and other domestic relations, including marriage, divorce, wills, succession, adoption, and many such personal issues. He discussed that in India, the most important subject under Family law is considered to be the subject of marriages. The matters of these religions have a different set of laws, especially in the case of the institution of marriage. The resource person had an interactive session with the students and he threw light on the concept of Marriage which is acknowledged by all civilized societies. He said

that due to the diversity of religious practices, the Indian legal system has different codified laws for each religion. Hindu marriages are regulated under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 while the Muslim Marriage Act, 1957 deals with Muslim marriages. He laid stress on various important and recent judgements on live in relationship, same sex marriage etc.

Director Sir Dr. P.M. Johri graced the event with their presence and enlightened the students about the same. The Session was very interactive and enlightening, almost all the students participated in it. Their queries were also solved by exchange of views. The session was a very fruitful one. Total 97 students of BA/BBA LLB 5<sup>th</sup> semester attended the session.
