This session intended to develop the personality of the students for becoming noble legal personnel since law students are the budding lawyers and will be contributing to the legal profession. The key speaker of the session was Ms. Isha Sharma Director (Founder) Trayambak Overseas Pvt. Ltd. Delhi and is an expert in Intellectual Property Rights.



The Workshop began with warm welcome by Dr Vikas Gupta and Dr. Neelam Seam by presenting the Sapling to Ms. Isha Sharma. Ms. Isha Sharma started the session by discussing that the lawyer's contribution is a holistic in nature. The practical approach should be adopted with regard to the field of legal professional and suggested to follow the BCI guidelines. She discussed about the legal field that is expanding in the area of Digitization and Cyber Law and how the budding lawyers should be diverse to take up the role and career opportunities. Ms. Isha had an interactive session with the students and discussed about the personality traits like how to comfort the client and to build up the relationship with the client who approaches to file the complaint or who approaches to take the advice for proceeding further. Ms. Isha also discussed about the different areas of law field i.e. Civil, Criminal, Judiciary, Corporate and NGO's and interacted with the students by asking about their interest of area. She concluded the session by suggesting the students that as upcoming lawyers they should imbibe in themselves the qualities like team management, team work and interpersonal skills and also to have soft skills.
