Before the commencement of the session, Dr. P.M. Johri (Director, giBS) welcomed the speaker with sapling. Dr. Subhash Sharma started the session by discussing the importance of human rights and how it creates a safe place for students to explore, discuss, challenge and form their own opinions and values. He then elaborated on the human rights evolution. He explained how Human Rights have continued to evolve since its foundation. He discussed the 20 principal treaties including conventions to prevent and prohibit specific abuses like torture and genocide and to protect particularly vulnerable populations, such as refugees (Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees, 1951), women (Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women, 1979), and children (Convention on the Rights of the Child, 1989) that has been adopted by the United Nations. He also explained the different perspective on human rights and at the end he adds what are the major Human Rights issues of the future.

The strength of 76 students from MBA & MBA IB (1<sup>ST</sup> AND 3<sup>RD</sup> Semester) attended the Personality Development Workshop.
