Mr. Param Bhamra started the session by discussing that if someone wants to have a startup they need to decide which field, when and where to be started. Now a days since an individual expects flexibility and to have control on one's own life. Therefore they opt for their own startup. He also discussed that the major thing required is the networking with various people and to personally know them to reach heights. He discussed about his own startup i.e. Mediate Guru and how he established it.

Ms Ayushi Sharma was the second Speaker for the session and discussed about the investments schemes which can be availed by the upcoming lawyers to start a startup by taking Startup Scheme which is available in India or the MSME scheme. She also enlightened about the various kinds of other startups such as Ipleaders, Presto 360, Lawcus etc.
