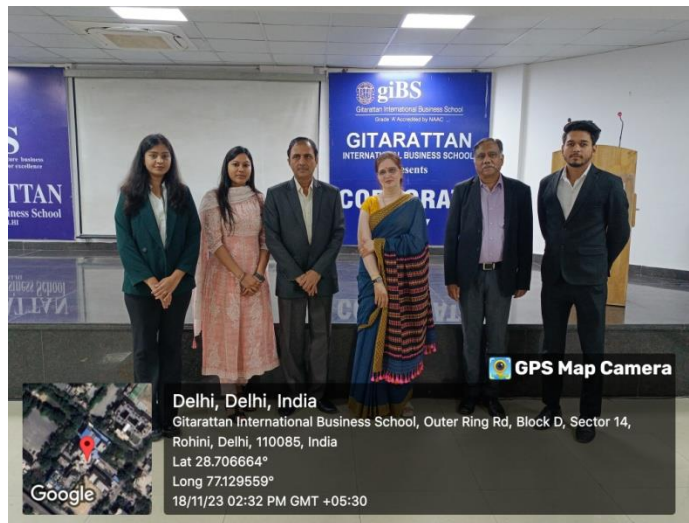


**FINANCE WORKSHOP ON

The speaker for the 2<sup>nd</sup> session was Ms. Kavita Thakur, Founder of Trigo Solutions. The workshop provided an invaluable exploration into the intricate intersection of financial technology and regulatory landscapes, offering aspiring student entrepreneurs a comprehensive understanding of the hurdles and opportunities within the dynamic Fintech sector. Through engaging presentations, real-world case studies, and interactive discussions, participants gained practical insights into the multifaceted regulatory challenges facing Fintech startups. Prof. (Dr.) Muneesh Kumar focused on complex regulatory frameworks and also inspired creative thinking, encouraging budding entrepreneurs to view compliance as a catalyst for innovative solutions. He explained types of Fintech companies, their dimensions and the value creation by focusing on various business models. He further explained the difference between Fintech and banking Vs. Fintech in banking. Ms. Kavita thakur explained on 3 important aspect of Fintech industry: WHAT IT IS? HOW IT WORKS & HOW IT HELPS? She explained why business fails, what are the challenges that young entrepreneurs face nowadays and how to overcome them. By the workshop's conclusion, students were equipped with the knowledge and strategies essential for navigating the regulatory complexities inherent in the fintech industry, empowering them to confidently embark on their entrepreneurial journeys while ensuring their ventures thrive within legal boundaries and contribute to the ongoing evolution of financial technology.
