The 3rd Annual Lex Fiesta

2nd – 5th NOVEMBER 2023

On 2nd November 2023, The Court Room Society of Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School successfully organized its 3rd Law fest, Justitia 2023- The 3rd Annual Lex Fiesta. The brochure was released prior to the competition and all the students from different universities across the country enthusiastically participated in the event and competition was fierce among the team. The event started with the Inaugural ceremony and graced with blessings of Goddess Saraswati with lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries which was followed by a Welcome speech by, Prof Dr Vikas Nath, Director, GIBS. The event was graced by the presence of Hon'ble Chief Guest Prof. (Dr) Paramjeet Jaswal Vice Chairmen of SRM University. He motivated the students with his words of wisdom and inspired them regarding the spirit of competition. The inaugural session concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Neelam Seam, Event Coordinator, GIBS.

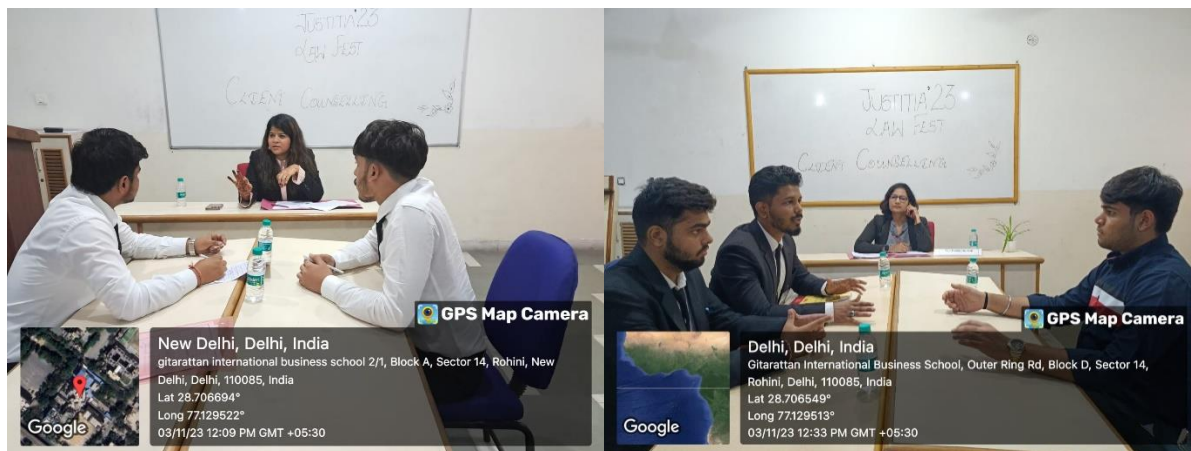


After inauguration, the preliminary rounds of Mediation Competition began, wherein 24 teams contested for qualifying for the semi-finals. All participants presented their negotiations before

their respective judges in various rooms. Esteemed panel of judge helped in choosing the best teams which were to compete in the semi-finals. Finally, Semi-Final Round was conducted and two teams emerged as finalists.



On Day 2, the day started with the final round of mediation took place. Both the teams showcased their hard-work and skills. Then it started with the registration of Client Counseling Competition for the law students. Total 20 teams registered for the competition each team was consisting of two students and it was divided into a total of 2 rounds: Prelims with 4 slots and Final round with 4 slots. All the law students enthusiastically participated in the event and competition was fierce among the teams. Competition started at 11 am. Each team was allotted 15 min. time which was divided into 10 min. time for client consultation period and 5 min for post interview period. Theme of the competition was related to cyber law and criminal law. The top 4 teams in the Finals were adjudged as Winners and Runners-up.

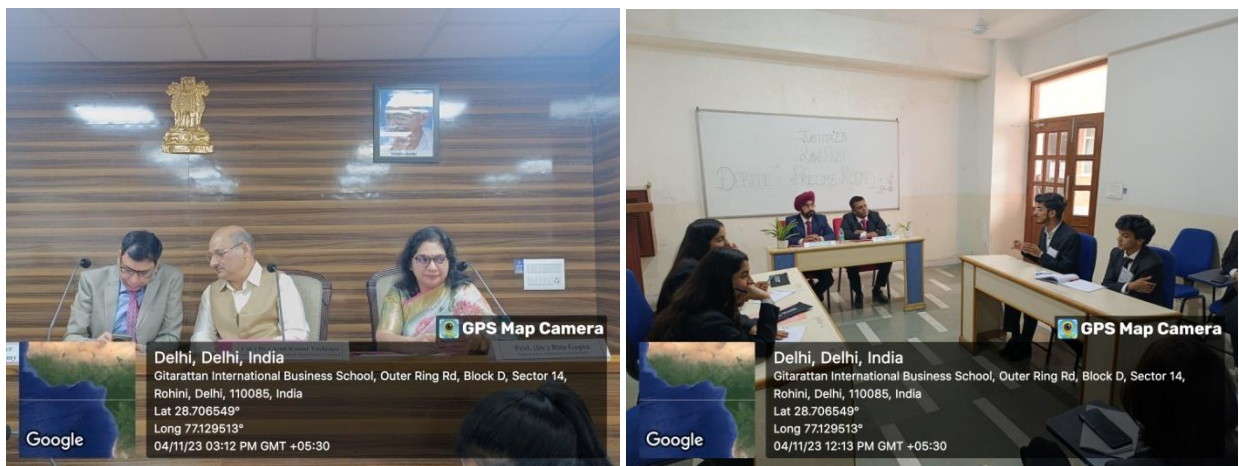




Simultaneously, the Juris Quest Quiz was conducted in the online mode, the quiz aimed to promote legal knowledge, encourage teamwork, and provide an enjoyable learning experience. The Juris Quest Quiz at Justitia comprised three intriguing rounds, each designed to engage and challenge the participating teams. In the first round, "Sight Sprint," 21 teams competed. This was the pictorial round, where participants were presented with visual clues related to legal concepts, famous cases, or legal symbols. They had to identify legal personalities, landmarks, or iconic legal scenes from carefully selected images. The second round, "Eye Escape," featured 10 teams. In this visual round, participants were tested on their observation and deduction skills. The final round, "Speed Blitz," was a rapid-fire auction round with four remaining teams. In this high-paced round, participants had to bid for legal areas. The team with the highest bid had the opportunity to answer the question. The competitiveness and time pressure made this round particularly thrilling.



On 3rd day of the Justitia i.e., on 4th November 2023, the day started with the registration of Debate Competition for the Law students. Total 24 teams registered for the competition, each team consisting of 2 students and it was divided into 3 rounds, that is, 2 rounds of prelims and 1 final round. The topic for prelim round was “Medical Termination of Pregnancy: Right of Reproduction v/s Right of Life of Unborn” and the topic for final was “Sedition Laws: Use and Misuse”. It was a great learning experience for the participants especially as the judges shared insightful advice on how to become better debaters and public speakers. The event provided a great opportunity for participants to showcase their public speaking and debating skills, to put forward their opinion and prove that they are confident orators. The Final round of the Competition was conducted before three judge’s bench, Col. (Dr.) Arun Kumar Vashishta working as an Advocate Delhi High Court & Armed Forces Tribunal; Mr. Naresh Grover, Director, Juris Academy and Prof. (Dr.) Ritu Gupta, Professor of Law National Law University Delhi.



Simultaneously, the National Law Olympiad was conducted in the online mode from 2:30pm-4:00pm. NLO is an online exam which was conducted on the online portal of Gibs. It is an online competition in which different colleges have participated. There are 73 colleges who have registered for this competition from different states. There was an online orientation which was conducted on zoom from 2:00 pm to 2:30pm before the exam to resolve the issues of the

participants so the test can be conducted smoothly. There are a total 63 participants in the zoom meeting. Somansh sharma from Op Jindal University is the winner of this competition.



On 3rd & 4th day of the Justitia i.e., 4th November and 5th November, 2023 GIBS, MUNC (MUN) Competition was conducted comprising two committees- United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) and All India Political Parties Meet (AIPPM). Model United Nations, also known as Model UN or MUN, is an activity in which Participants typically role plays delegates to the United Nations and simulates UN and Indian committees. The timings for the first day of committees began from 10 a.m. and ended by 5p.m with 3 sessions. The second day of the committees began by 9:30 a.m. and ended by 2p.m with 2 sessions, with over 64 delegates from different universities across the country. At the end of the conferences, outstanding delegates in each committee are recognized and given an award certificate; the Best Delegate in each committee. Various number of participants around the world participate in Model United Nations, which involves substantial researching, public speaking, debating, and writing skills, as well as critical thinking, teamwork, and leadership abilities. After, the conclusion of the MUN, competition, the winners were announced in the valedictory ceremony. Winners of all the events were announced and awarded prizes and trophy in the valedictory ceremony.
