

## IIC WORKSHOP ON "ACHIEVING PROBLEM SOLUTION FIT AND PRODUCT MARKET FIT" 21 DECEMBER 2023











The IIC workshop was conducted for students of BBA Semester III (evening shift) with the aim to provide budding entrepreneurs, and startup enthusiasts with insights, strategies, and practical tips on navigating the crucial phases of problem-solution fit and product-market fit in the product development lifecycle. Guests Ms Pooja Kumar, Director, Innove Intellects LLP and Mr Chandan Tiwari, Founder & CEO, thehostel.in were warmly welcomed by the event coordinator Ms Ravleen Kaur, Assistant Professor, GIBS.

Mr Tiwari told the importance of problem-solution fit and product-market fit in building successful products. He said that primarily identifying and defining the problem that your product intends to solve is most important. For that conducting effective customer interviews and feedback sessions must be conducted. He quoted real-world case studies of Hutch, Vodafone, Tata & MTNL illustrating successful problem identification thereby introducing various call plans by these companies to captured the market while resolving problem of the customer.

According to him, analyzing market trends and competitive landscapes were also important to strategize for scaling and optimizing product-market fit. He took example of Hike, a messaging app, that faced challenges and gradually lost ground, while WhatsApp continued to thrive. With massive user base, user-friendly interface with essential features for messaging, sharing media, and making voice calls, global approach to marketing and updated features that adapted to changing user needs, Whatsapp had a straightforward approach to success, while Hike may not have been as agile in responding to market demands.

Mrs Pooja discussed patents, copyrights and GIC by way of animated video. She also told the importance, purpose and types of patents and copywrites by giving various examples of cases, such as Starbucks and Sardarjibucks, Bisleri and Bliseri, Blisri etc
