

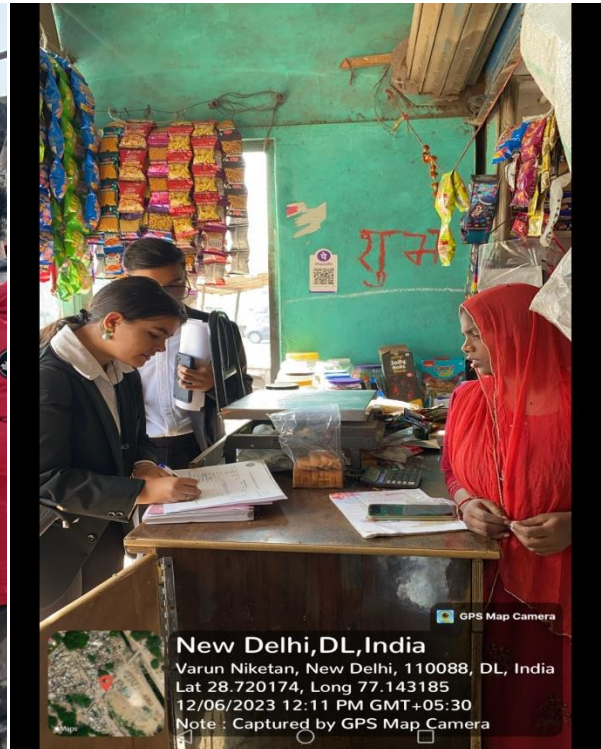
CENSUS QUEST – SURVEY

SURVEY BY LEGAL AID CLINIC GIBS

6th & 7th December, 2023 (WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY)

Gitarattan International Business School, Delhi, Centre for Legal Studies Legal Aid Clinic organized door-to-door survey at Ekta Village, Pitampura also known as Ekta Camp on 6th and 7th Dec 2023. The objective of the survey was to collect the family data of about 100 families living in Ekta Village and to make them aware about DLSA & how they can avail Free Legal Aid. It aimed to help bridge legal gaps and empower the community and was a crucial effort to empower residents of the slum area with information about their rights and access to free legal aid through DLSA and to enhance legal awareness and ensure that everyone has equal opportunities to avail themselves of legal support. Legal Aid Clinic of CLS-GIBS conducted the survey on the topic “Awareness about the roles and responsibilities of DLSA”.

PLVs of GIBS Legal Aid Clinic intricately delved into the personal details of each family, meticulously recording information about the household head, family size, monthly income, educational background, and contact details. Beyond these vital details, the questionnaire tactfully incorporated legal inquiries, probing the residents’ awareness of DLSA, their understanding of rights, and the mechanisms available for availing them. Notably, the survey played a dual role— not only capturing data but also acting as an educational tool. Participants were informed about the locations of DLSA offices, and a helpline number was shared, emphasizing avenues for assistance. Delving further, the survey tactfully explored residents’ past legal experiences, gauging whether they had sought legal help previously, thereby ensuring a nuanced understanding of the community’s legal needs.





On Wednesday morning of December 6th, the day one survey kicked off promptly at 9:30 AM, extending its reach and impact until 2:00 pm. The orchestrated efforts of the students, guided by the experienced hand of Supervisor BK Yadav, culminated in a resounding success. The experience of day 1 not only achieved its objectives but also laid the foundation for subsequent days, setting a promising tone for the continuation of this noble initiative. By the end of day 1 the students covered 50 families living in the slums and made them aware about the functions of DLSA and the provision of free legal aid.

The collective efforts of the dedicated team bore fruit, marking another triumph in this community-driven initiative. Impressively, the survey not only sustained its momentum but exceeded expectations by covering more than 50 additional houses. This accomplishment propelled the overall count well beyond the set target of engaging with 100 families residing in the slum area. The residents, reached through this extensive survey, were not only informed about DLSA but were also enlightened about the avenues available for accessing free legal aid. This day, like its predecessor, stands as a testament to the commitment and effectiveness of the collaborative efforts put forth by the team.
