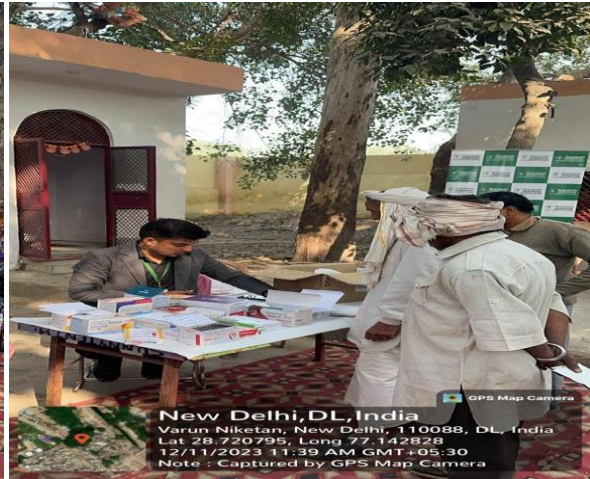



“HEALTH CAMP”
AN INITIATIVE UNDER 10 DAYS SPECIAL CAMP
11TH DECEMBER 2023 (MONDAY)





NSS Unit of Gitarattan International Business School set up a health camp at the Ekta Camp on 11th Dec 2023 in collaboration with Santom Hospital. Under this activity over 150 residents who were underprivileged and cannot afford basic health treatments were provided with various health treatments and free medicines from experts. General physicians and gynecologists were also there. The project started from 10 am. This initiative aimed to address healthcare needs within the village, promote health awareness, and provide essential medical services to the residents.

Trained medical professionals from the Santom hospital conducted thorough medical check-ups for villagers. This included general health assessments, blood pressure checks, blood sugar screenings, and other basic health parameters. The health camp featured specialized consultations with doctors from various fields, addressing specific health concerns such as dental care, eye care, and women's health. Medicines prescribed during the health camp were distributed to individuals requiring immediate treatment. This ensured that residents had access to essential medications.
