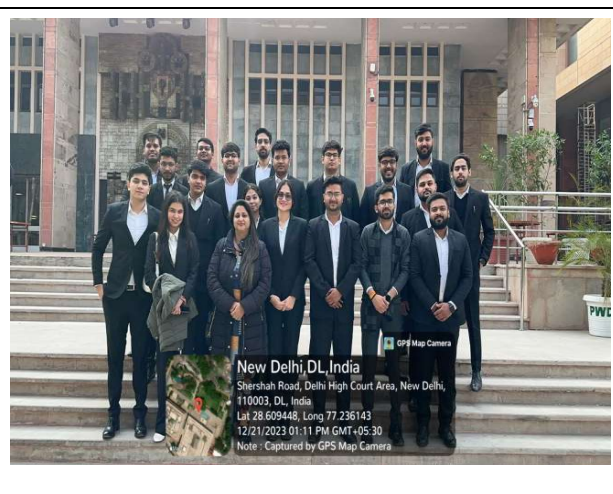


VISIT TO THE DELHI HIGH COURT

A visit to the **Delhi High Court** was organized by Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School wherein the students of BBA LLB Semester IX were accompanied by Ms. Sakshi Gupta, Assistant Professor, GIBS.
