

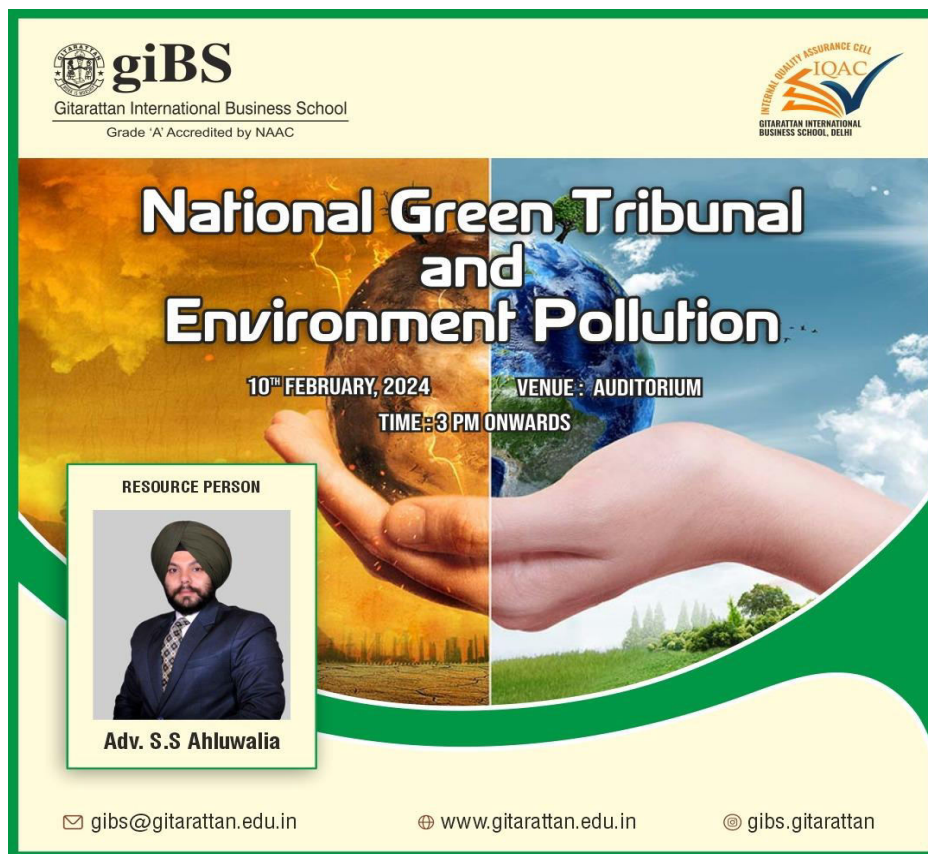
JURIST DAY ON NATIONAL GREEN TRIBUNAL AND ENVIRONMENT POLLUTION 10th FEBRUARY, 2024

Discussions centered on the NGT's effectiveness in providing speedy and efficient redressal of environmental grievances and ensuring compliance with environmental regulations. The event examined various forms of environmental pollution and provided insights into the sources of pollution such as industrial activities, vehicular emissions, construction projects, agricultural practices, and improper waste disposal. The role of regulatory bodies, government agencies, and local authorities in monitoring and controlling pollution levels was analyzed, along with the need for stringent enforcement mechanisms.
