


## ALUMNI LECTURE SERIES "INTRODUCTION TO MOOTING SKILLS" 15<sup>TH</sup> MARCH'2024

On 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024, Industry Institutes Partnership Cell (IIPC) of GIBS had the privilege of hosting an enlightening Alumni Lecture Series (ALS) titled "Introduction to Mooting Skills." The esteemed speaker for the event wasMr. Madhur Rathaur, a distinguished alumnus of our college and Co-Founder of LexPeeps Pvt. Ltd who not only excelled in academia but also carved a successful career as an entrepreneur in the legal industry. The lecture aimed to impart invaluable insights into the art of mooting, drawing from the speaker's rich experiences and expertise.





Mr Madhur commenced the lecture by sharing personal anecdotes and reflections on their journey from being a law student at GIBS to becoming a successful entrepreneur in the legal field. He emphasized the importance of mooting as a crucial component of legal education. He underscored how participation in moot court competitions equips students with practical advocacy skills, enhances their legal knowledge, and fosters critical thinking and problem-solving abilities. He asked the students to focus on three essentials while preparing for moot court competitions, namely Research, Preparation and Presentation.

He highlighted the importance of reading a moot proposition. He said "if you cannot argue on law, argue on facts." He distinguished the bench between hot bench and cold bench. He said that hot bench comprises of the judges who are proactive and ask many questions from the mooters whereas cold bench comprises of the judges who are more observant and judge the participants quietly. He also gave a tip to the students not to assume facts on their own, infact they should take this plea that the fact sheet is silent.

The session was an enriching and inspiring experience for all attendees. The session played an important role in representing the views of its alumni and contributing to build an engaged and supportive alumni community to help the institute grow exponentially. It is also committed to link closely with the institute support mentoring and intern opportunities. Leveraging the alumni community can be a win-win for both the institution and the alumni.
