

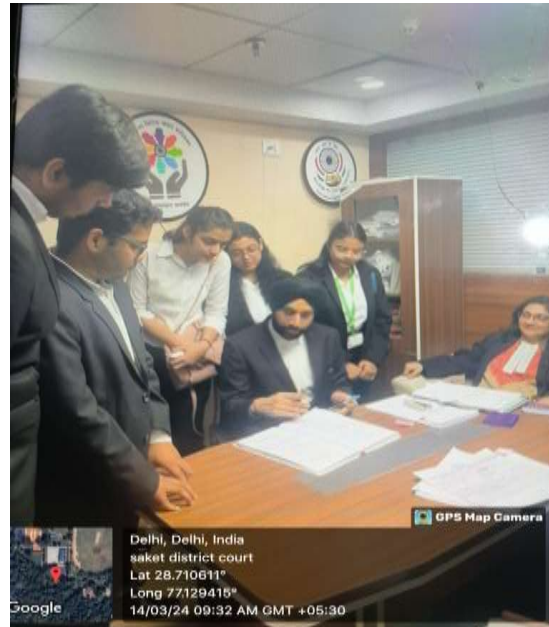
VISIT to HON'BLE DISTRICT COURT, SAKET

13th & 14th MARCH, 2024 (WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY)

CLS-GIBS, Delhi, organized a visit to the Hon'ble District Court, Saket for the students of BA LLB-2A & BBA LLB-2 Semester on 13th & 14th March, 2024.

The purpose of the visit was to understand the working of a court, the nature of duties of the judicial officers. The visit was to help understand the role of court in dispensing Justice in any case, the role of prosecutors in a case, the way a case proceeds in a court, the way judges, prosecutors and defence lawyers handle the case. This gave students an opportunity to understand the actual need of co-ordination in the system of justice.





On both days students gathered at DLSA first. Superintendent Ms. Geeta Rajput interacted with them and gave introduction of Delhi Legal Services Authority (DLSA) to the students. After the briefing, students were divided into four groups with 15 students in each unit. There were four DLSA Advocates for each group who guided them throughout the court tour.

Basic introduction to courtroom and its etiquettes was given. Then students were taken to the Meditation Room, where they witnessed how 2 clients via husband and wife seeks for maintenance. Next, they went to Vulnerable Witness Room, where POCSO, Sexual Harassment and other Criminal Cases were being resolved. Students were later back to DLSA, where they saw how advocates counselled their clients for free legal aid. They also saw proceedings of the Criminal court. Then students went to the Family Court of Justice Ms. Pritam where a Divorce Case was going on as per the Muslim Law Marriage Act. Hon'ble Judge Madam interacted with the questioned them about basic legal knowledge. At last they went to the Look-Up Block where the custodial officers showed the male and female prisoners' cells. Cell for UTPs named as Khasra were also shown where the Under Trial Prisoners (UTPs) were brought from jails like Tihar Jail, Rohini Jail for their respective case hearings. Officers also informed the students that Look-Up Block was directly connected to 15 jails in Delhi through underground tunnels for security reasons.
