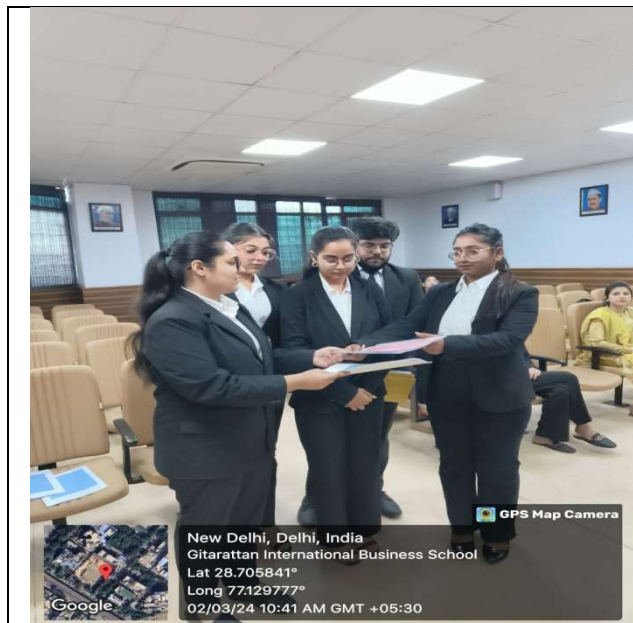
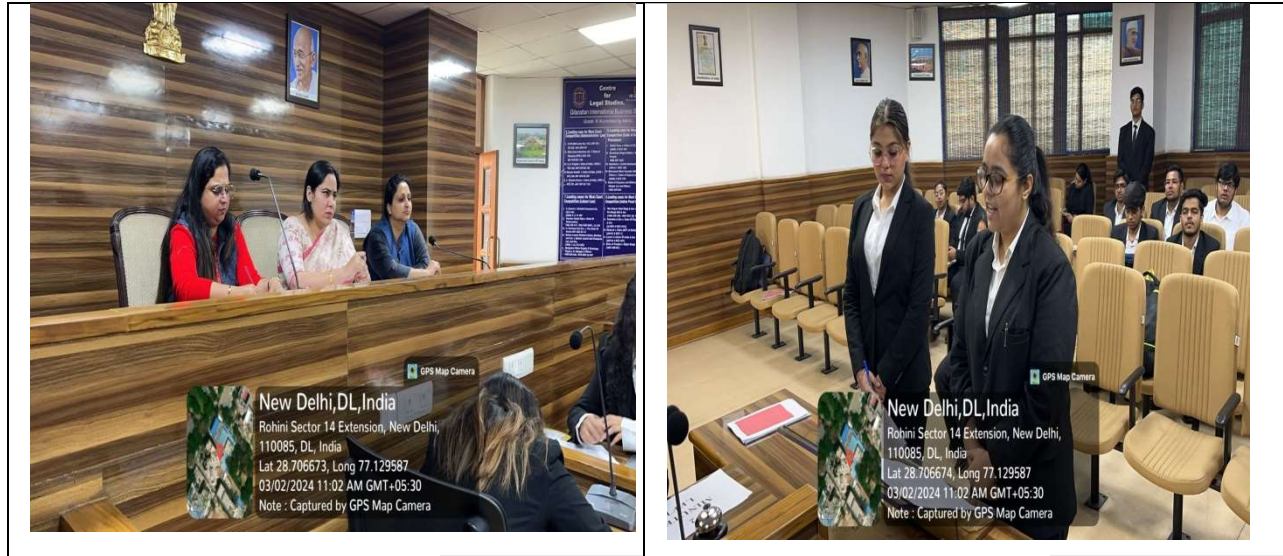


INTRA- MOOT COURT COMPETITION 2ND MARCH'2024

CLS-GIBS organized the Intra Moot Court Competition 2024 on 2nd March'2024 with the primary objective of selecting the best team to represent GIBS in the upcoming 6th National Moot Court Competitions. Moot court competitions serve as invaluable platforms for law students to hone their advocacy skills, apply legal knowledge to practical scenarios, and engage in rigorous legal argumentation. The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across various batches and streams within the college. It was structured to simulate a real courtroom experience, with participants arguing cases before a panel of esteemed judges. The cases presented were meticulously crafted to challenge participants' understanding of the law and their ability to construct persuasive legal arguments.






The session began with an introduction to the event by the Student anchor and briefing of the procedure to all the participants. It started with Draw of Lots followed by Memorial Exchange between the participating teams. Then the office be are represented a demo session showcasing courtroom etiquettes. Participants demonstrated exceptional legal research skills and articulated their arguments with clarity and precision. A panel of three judges Dr. Nidhi Sharma, Dr. Namita Fagaria and Ms. Sakshi Gupta judged the teams on skills like research, oration, presentation and court manners and gave them valuable insights on presentation, research and memorial drafting.
