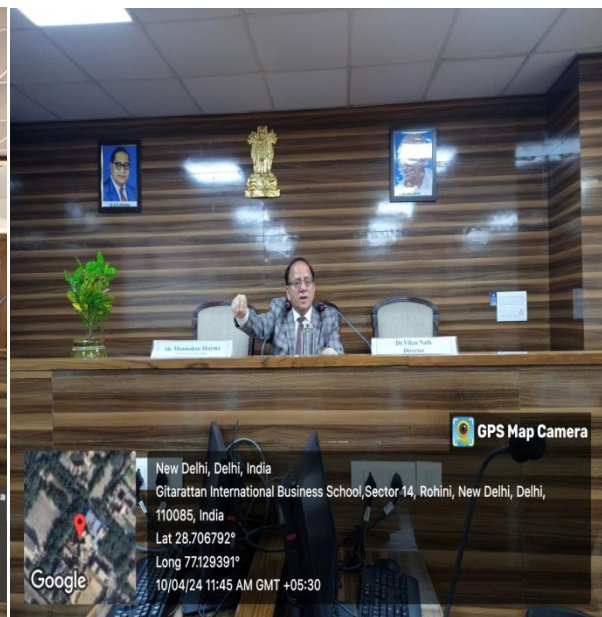
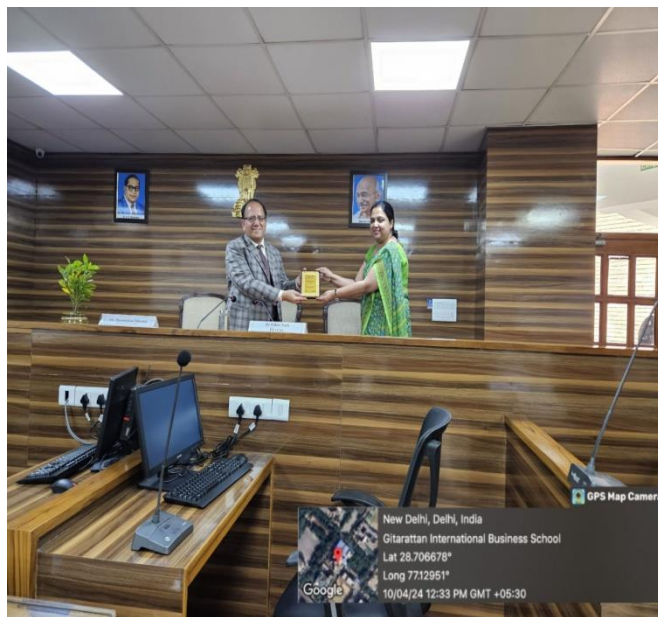


# JURIST DAY

## IMPORTANT SECTIONS OF CRPC & ITS RELEVANCE

### 10<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2024






CLS-GIBS organized Jurist Day 3 on the topic “Important Sections of CrPC : Relevance” on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024. The session aimed to familiarize participants with key sections of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC) and their significance in the context of criminal justice administration in India. The event was graced with the presence of Honorable Guest Sh. Manmohan Sharma, District & Sessions Judge, Director Administration Delhi Judicial Academy, Delhi. The guest was welcomed by Director Sir Prof. Dr. Vikas Nath with a sapling.

The session began with an overview of the Code of Criminal Procedure, its historical background, and its role in regulating criminal proceedings in India. Manmohan Ji enlightened the students about how criminal cases are investigated, tried, and appealed, fostering a more informed legal community. In the lecture he talked about the framework for the investigation, trial, and adjudication of criminal cases to make students understand the legal framework governing criminal proceedings. He provided an in-depth discussion of select sections of the CrPC deemed most relevant in criminal proceedings. He focused on the intricacies of criminal procedures, ensuring that participants are well-versed in the procedural aspects of investigation, trial, and appeal. Apart from

giving them theoretical knowledge, the students were also given examples of real-time cases to make them understand the intricacies of practical application of the rules laid down in the Criminal Procedural Law. The session concluded with a question-and-answer session, allowing participants to seek clarification on specific sections of CrPC or raise any related queries. The event ended with a presentation of memento to the esteemed Guest by Dr. Nidhi Sharma and the event ended on a successful note.
