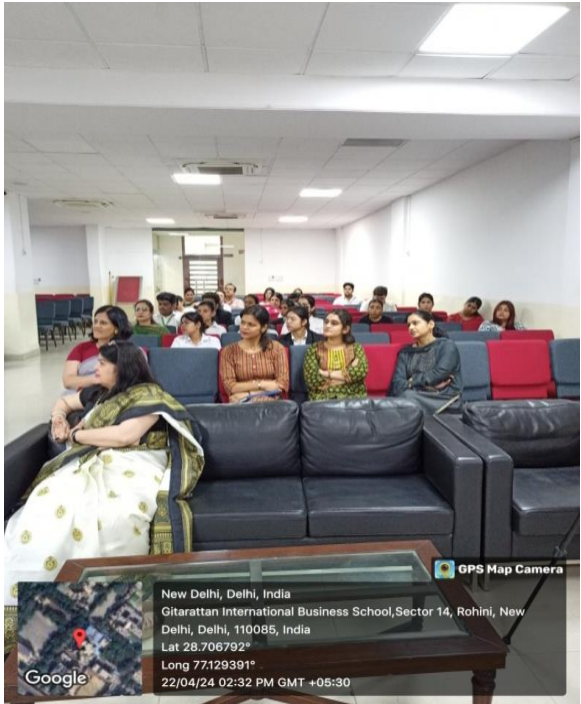
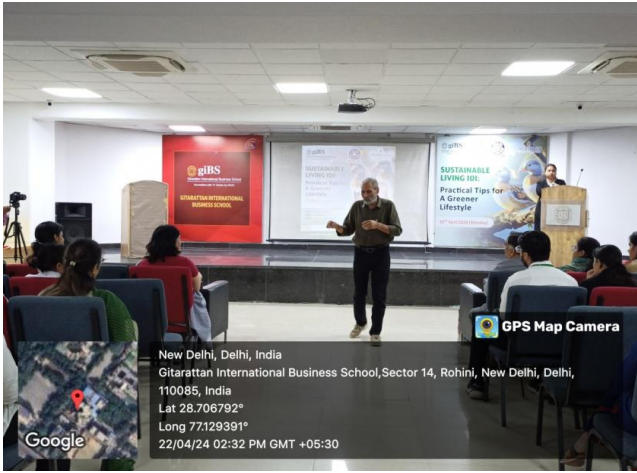


SUSTAINABLE LIVING 101: PRACTICAL TIPS FOR A GREENER LIFESTYLE

However, loss of habitat due to urbanization, deforestation, and pollution has threatened bird populations worldwide. the focal points of the discussion was preparing nesting sites for birds. This involves providing suitable nesting materials and creating safe and secure locations for nesting. The speaker highlighted the importance of using natural materials such as twigs, grass, and leaves to mimic birds' natural habitats. In conclusion, creating sustainable habitats for birds is not only beneficial for avian populations but also contributes to overall environmental conservation. Lastly a vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Neelam Seam. Students and faculty appreciated the talk and promised that they will ensure at least one nest for the birds.
