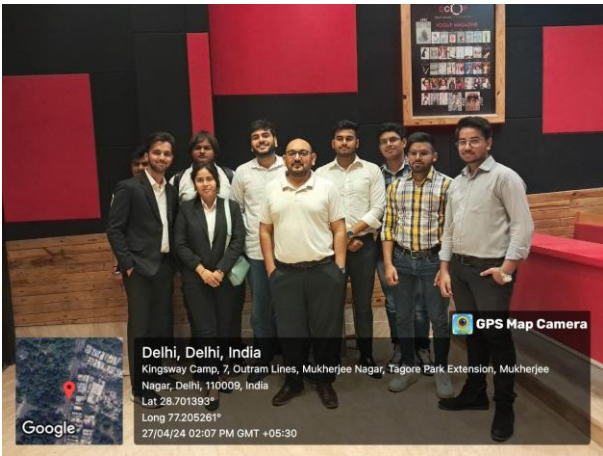
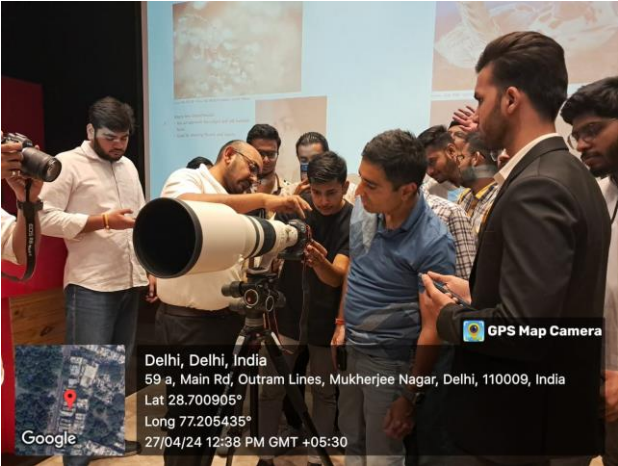


INTERMEDIATE PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP 27.04.2024 – SATURDAY
