

ACADEMIC VISIT TO FAMILY COURT, ROHINI COURTS

4th & 5th APRIL, 2024



Gitarattan International Business School organized an Academic visit to the Family Court, Rohini Courts, New Delhi. The visit was organized for BA LLB 4A students to enhance the knowledge of their domain. The visit was organized for making the students aware of the functioning of Family Courts and also the practical aspects of the family law since they have studied family law in the last semester and are continuing with the same in this semester. GIBS strongly believe that providing the students with hands-on experience of procedures can work wonders in instilling in them a sense of discipline and responsibility. Students reported at the venue on time i.e. 11:30am. The students were instructed by the faculty coordinator about the Rules and the decorum to be maintained inside the Court Room. The students attended the court room of Mr. Neeraj Gaur, Ld. ASJ (N.W.- Rohini) on 4.4.2024 and Mr. Dinesh Bhatt's (Principal Judge, Family Courts) Courtroom on 5.4.2024.

The students got to experience what they learnt in the classrooms with respect to marriage, divorce, adoption, maintenance laws etc. being applied in the real case scenarios. The students particularly saw a case of domestic violence which intrigued them. In that case, the wife was allowed an interim maintenance of Rs. 7000 owing to the violence being caused against her. The students also raised doubts with the concerned faculty supervisor with respect to the procedure and functioning of the courtroom since they are only well-versed with the theoretical aspects of law.

Along with this, students learned the etiquettes which are to be observed in courts and the discipline which is to be maintained in the courts.
