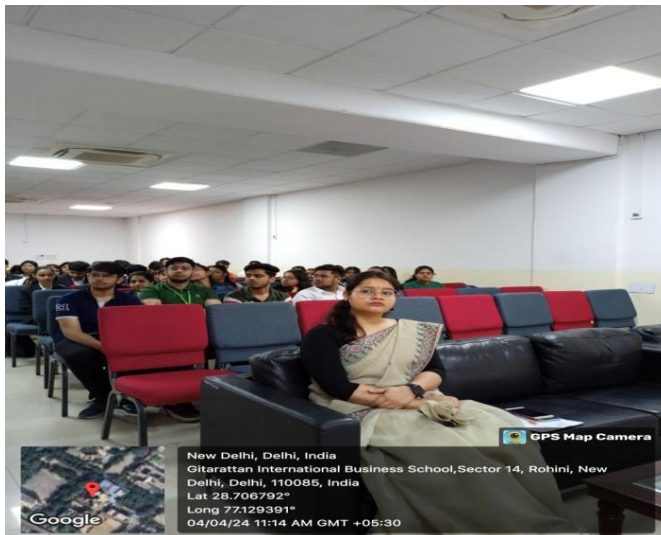


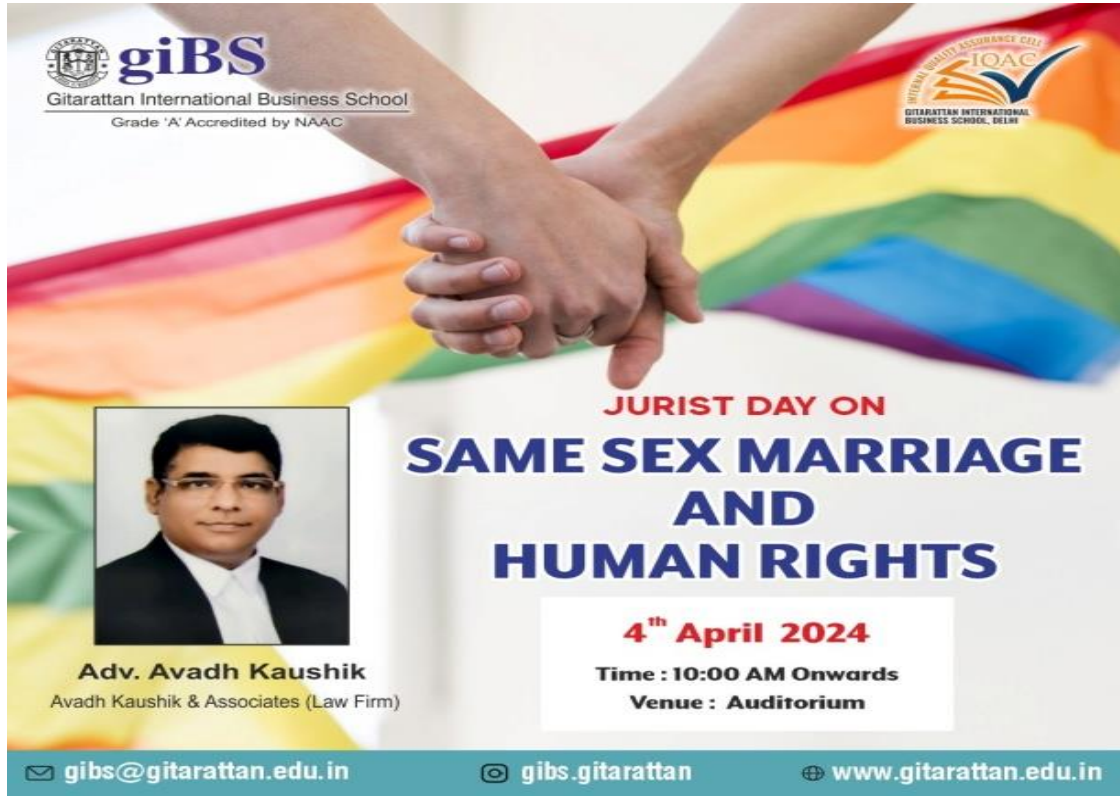
JURIST DAY ON SAME SEX MARRIAGE AND HUMAN RIGHTS 4TH APRIL 2024



The Centre for Legal Studies at GIBS conducted a talk for law students of second semester on "Same-Sex Marriage And Human Rights" featuring Mr Avadh Bihari Kaushik, an esteemed Advocate of the Supreme Court, as the resource person. The aim of the talk was to delve into the intersection of same-sex marriage and human rights, exploring the legal, social, and ethical dimensions surrounding this issue.

The speaker provided an overview of the legal landscape concerning same-sex marriage globally. This included highlighting countries where same-sex marriage is legal, those with pending legislation, and nations where it remains illegal.
