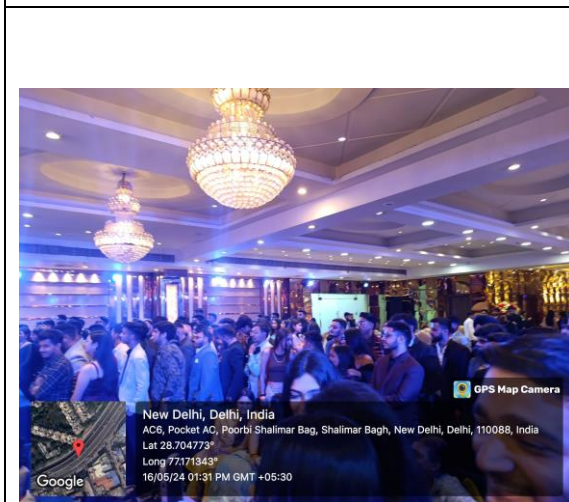


# ABHIVYAKTI - THE FAREWELL
