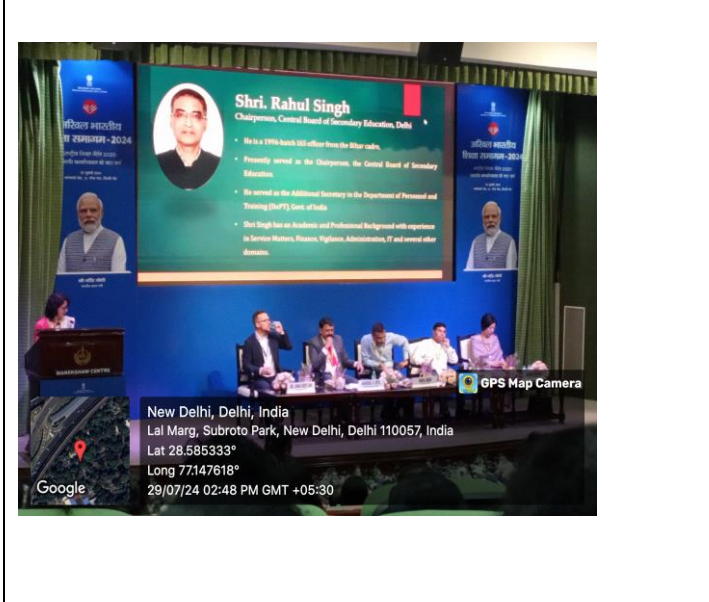
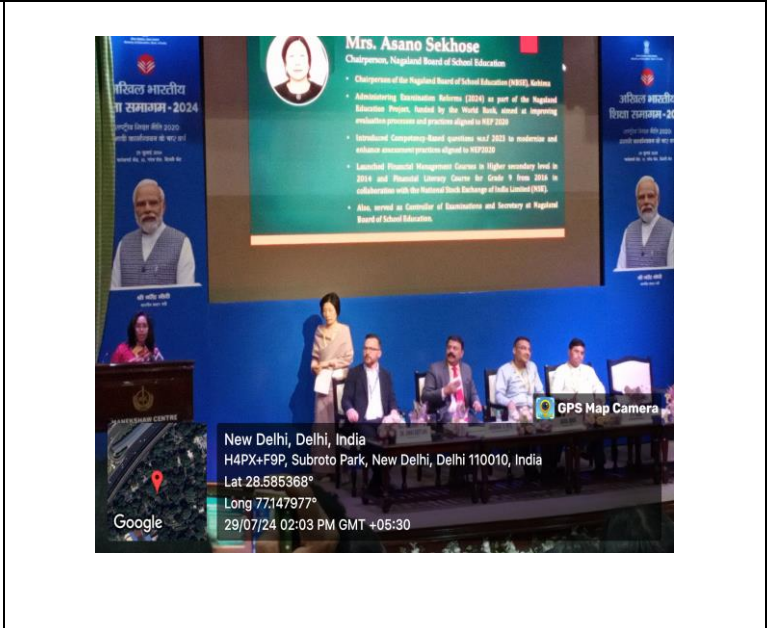


# AICTE AKHIL BHARTIYA SAMAGAM 29<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2024



The Ministry of Education celebrated the 4<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 with Akhil Bhartiya Shiksha Samagam 2024 in New Delhi's Manekshaw Centre Auditorium on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2024. The event, attended by key ministers, officials, academicians, and students, featured the release of books and lecture notes by the Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) Division. The celebration also included the launch of several significant initiatives and a series of thematic sessions on various NEP 2020-related topics.

Shri Jayant Chaudhary, Union Minister of State and Dr. Sukanta Majumdar, Union Minister of State in the Ministry of Education; and Minister of State in the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region were present at the event.
