

**“SESSION ON WATER CONSERVATION”**  
*(UNDER NSS 10-DAYS SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL CAMP)*  
**18<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2024 (WEDNESDAY)**



The NSS Unit of Gitarattan International Business School has organized a campaign on Water Conservation in collaboration with the Pranabhuti Foundation in our adopted village Ekta camp near Pitampura on 18<sup>th</sup> September 2024. This event took place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the 10-days special residential camp. with the objective of educating residents on the importance of conserving water and sharing practical methods for reducing water wastage. The initiative aimed to empower the community to take proactive steps toward sustainable water use, contributing to a healthier environment and improved quality of life. The event lasted from 3:00 pm-4:30 pm.

Mr Vinod from Pranabhuti foundation explained the village dwellers on the ways and methods through which they can utilize water and treat unclean water. He led the event, offering interactive sessions, demonstrations, and practical tips on water conservation. The event commenced with an introductory session on the significance of water conservation, followed by hands-on activities to help participants understand simple ways to reduce water usage in their daily routines. Ways to conserve water and how to minimize water wastage was explained by Mr Vinod in detail with help of posters and models.

He discussed the current water crisis, both globally and locally, explaining the causes of water scarcity and the impact on health, agriculture, and daily life. Practical tips for reducing water consumption were shared with participants, focusing on simple methods that could easily be implemented at home. Some key suggestions included fixing leaks promptly, use buckets instead of running taps for tasks like washing dishes and clothes, and bathing, reuse water from washing vegetables and fruits for watering plants or cleaning. He briefly explained how collected rainwater could be used for non-drinking purposes, such as cleaning and gardening.

The event was a success as the village dwellers especially the children showed great interest in learning about water conservation. Children being the future of our country it was satisfying seeing them learn. By raising awareness and promoting simple, actionable steps, the NSS Unit aims to foster a community-wide commitment to conserving water and protecting the environment.
