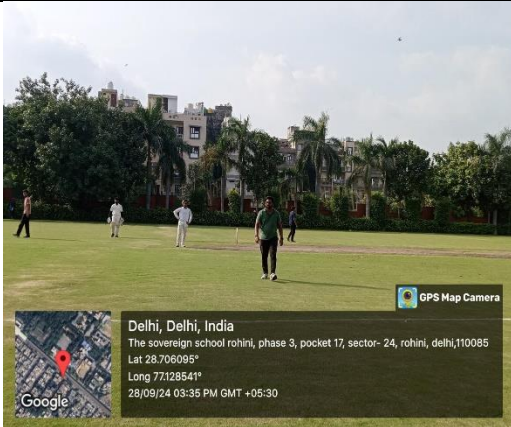


# INTRA COLLEGESPORTS MEET
