The NSS Unit of Gitarattan International Business School organized an **Eye Immunization and Eye Care Check-Up Event** under the 10days special camp which was held in collaboration with **Mishti Eye Care** on 25th September 2024 in our adopted village Ekta Camp near pitampura. This event was organized on the 9th day of the 10 days special camp. The event started at 3:00 PM and ended at 6:30 PM. Our focus was on providing free eye check-ups for the residents of Ekta Camp. The goal was to raise awareness about eye health and offer early diagnosis for those who might be at risk of developing vision-related issues, ensuring that individuals with limited access to healthcare could benefit from professional care.

During the event, every resident was given a free eye examination by qualified eye doctors. Participants actively engaged with the doctors, sharing their eye-related issues and receiving personalized advice. For those with early signs of eye problems, the doctors provided guidance on preventive measures and treatments. Residents were also given recommendations on how to improve their eye health through lifestyle changes, such as proper nutrition, eye hygiene, and reducing screen time.
