THE 4TH ANNUAL LEX FIESTA

7TH- 10TH NOVEMBER 2024 (THURSDAY – SUNDAY)

On 7th November 2024, The Court Room Society of Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School successfully organized its 4th Annual Lex Fiesta, Justitia 4.0. The brochure was released before the competition, and students from universities across the country eagerly took part, resulting in intense competition among the teams. The ceremony served as a platform to honor the confluence of legal knowledge, professional skill development, and cultural engagement, welcoming distinguished guests, respected faculty, and a dynamic gathering of students from across the country.

The event began with a warm welcome extended to the esteemed dignitaries, including the Chief Guest Hon'ble Justice Mr. Vijender Jain Former Chief Justice Punjab & Haryana and Delhi High Court, who graced the occasion with their presence. The ceremony commenced with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp, symbolizing the illumination of knowledge and the pursuit of justice, accompanied by a soulful invocation to set a positive tone for the event.

The inaugural ceremony also provided an overview of the key events planned for the fest, which included **Resolva Con (Mediation)**, **Clash of Minds (Debate)**, **Forensics Fanatics (Crime Scene Investigation)**, **The Parliament Pulse (Youth Parliament)**, **Client Connect (Client Counselling)**, **Legal Divine (Law Olympiad)**, and the much-anticipated **7th National Moot Court Competition**.

The inauguration ceremony concluded with a heartfelt vote of thanks extended by the Director of GIBS, who expressed gratitude to the distinguished guests, faculty members, participants, and organizing teams for their invaluable contributions. The emphasis was on the collaborative efforts that made the event possible, reflecting the spirit of teamwork and dedication that JUSTITIA embodies.

After Inauguration, Preliminary rounds of Meditation Competition started with total 24 teams from all over India. The competition was divided into four parts Pre 1, Pre 2, Semi-final and Final. Draw of lots was done before the competition online platform. On the day of the event the judges of preliminary and semifinal were given a briefing of the competition structure, rules, and evaluation criteria. Adv. Inderjeet Siddhu, Adv. Sandhya Kohli, Adv. Sangeeta Mehrotra, Adv. Atul Batra, Adv. Jasbir Kaur, Adv. Puja were the judges of the semi-finals.



On the 2nd Day two teams were qualified for the final. The judges for the final round were Advocate Jitender Pal Sengh, Adv. Amrit Kaur Oberoi, Adv. Kajal Chandra. Jamia Millia Islamia emerged as the winner and Delhi Metropolitan Education secured the runner-up position. Delhi Metropolitan Education secures the best mediator and Christ University got best mediating pair. The competitions focused on assessing participants' ability to work together, effectively manage conflicts and find creative solutions.

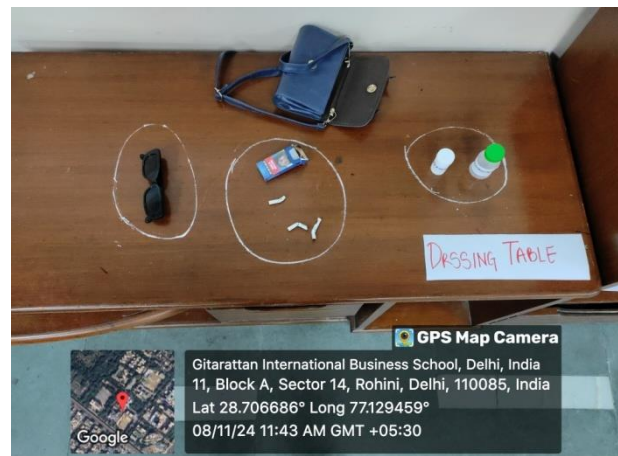


On the 2nd Day i.e. 8th November 2024, the day started with the registration of **Law Debate Competition** for the Law students. This year's event focused on the pressing topic of Are current cybercrime laws in India effective in combating online harassment? which sparked vibrant discussions among participating students. The event saw enthusiastic participation from students from different colleges who presented their fierce views and debating skills over the provided topic. The participants in Final round who represented the for and against motions for the provided topic in two rounds were Sachin Kumar Choudhary, Avni from Ishan Institute and Pranjal Gupta, Aditi Singh from Asian law college in first round And Siddharth Upadhyay, Arpit Chaudhary from Dr. Akhilesh Das

Simultaneously on 8th November 2024, Crime Scene Investigation Competition was organized. The event, held over one day, brought together over 21 teams from prestigious law colleges and universities across India. The Crime Scene Investigation encourages students to expand their knowledge of law, explore emerging legal issues, and stay informed about contemporary judicial trends. The panels of judges for the competition were Prof. Dr Rakhi Agarwal, Dean Academics (I/c) Department of Forensic Sciences; Dr. Drashti Bhuptani Sagav, Senior Forensic Expert & Crime Scene Investigator, Crime Branch, Delhi Police; Adv. Pradeep Nawani (Founder of Pradeep Nawani & Associates; Mr. Rajeev Malik, ACP -Sultanpuri, Delhi Police & Dr. Amar Pal Singh Shokeen Assistant Director of Chemistry Forensic Science Laboratory Delhi.



On the 3rd Day, i.e. 9th November 2024, the day started with registration of Client Counselling with and it witnessed participation from 19 teams. Each team consists of two students as Counsel 1 and Counsel 2. There was one student from the event coordinators who portrayed the role of client for the participating teams. Majorly, the participating students were from 2nd and 3rd year. The preposition for the prelims round of client counseling revolved around contractual breach and fraudulent financial services in which a company has made discrepancies in their annual statements. The Panel of 3 judges was present for the Final Round, Adv. Bharat Bhushan, Adv. Sakshi and Adv. Vikrant Sharma. The preposition for Final Round was primarily based on the POSH Act.



Simultaneously on 9th November 2024, Law Olympiad was organized virtually, The virtual event, held over one day, brought together over 100 participants from prestigious law colleges and universities across India. The event featured a comprehensive quiz comprising 100 questions designed to test participants on diverse areas of law, including constitutional, criminal, general studies and international law. After a brief introduction and overview of the rules, participants were given a set time to complete the quiz. The atmosphere was charged with excitement as students focused intently, demonstrating their legal acumen and quick thinking.



On the 3rd and 4th Day of Justitia 2024 i.e. 9th & 10th November 2024, Youth Parliament was organized. This year's event focused on the pressing topic of the ONE NATION, ONE VOTE which sparked vibrant discussions among participating students. The event saw enthusiastic participation from students who took on various significant portfolios, embodying notable personalities, including Shri Narendra Modi, Shri Antony, Dr. C.N Manjunath, Smt. Geeta Kora, Amit Shah, Kiren Rijiju, Rahul Gandhi, Rajesh Ranjan, Ms. S. Jothi Mani etc. Each student effectively represented their assigned figure, contributing unique perspectives and engaging in robust debates surrounding the implications of the One nation, One vote on society. The discussions were marked by high energy, as students articulated their views and engaged with opposing arguments.



On the 4th Day of Justitia 2024, i.e. 10th November 2024, the day started with the Semi Final Rounds of Moot Court Competition, with 4 teams who qualified for this round. The preliminary rounds of Moot Court took place on 26th November 2024 via Online Mode and total 27 teams from various law colleges across India, including several National Law Universities, reflecting the event's prestige in legal academia participated in the competition.

The Moot proposition for this year's event was both challenging and topical, incorporating legal issues pertaining to the BNS Act, the BNSS Act, and the Dowry Prohibition Act. The judging panel consisted of highly esteemed figures from the legal profession, including respected advocates and dignitaries from top-tier law firms: Adv. Rajinder Singh, Dr. Ritu Gupta, Dr. Sunanda Bharti, Adv. Randhawa, Smt. Priyanka Singh, and Col. Vashishta.



After the conclusions of the Youth Parliament competition, the winners were announced in the valedictory ceremony. The valedictory ceremony commenced with a warm welcome to all attendees, Winners and runners-up from each competition and Chief Guest of the Event i.e. Hon'ble Justice Dr. Sudhir Jain High Court of Delhi honored the Winners with a range of rewards, including cash prizes, certificates, trophies, and internship opportunities. These accolades not only celebrated their achievements but also provided tangible incentives to continue striving for excellence in their legal careers. The variety of competitions ensured that participants had the opportunity to showcase their talents in multiple domains, from legal reasoning and advocacy to negotiation and public speaking.
