India marks National Education Day on November 11th, to memorialize the birthday of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Minister for Education in India. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad's exemplary contributions to the field of education and institution-building paved the way for the country's modern system of education. A Guest Lecture on "National Education Day" on the theme of "Empowering the future through quality education" was conducted for the students of BBA MIC on 11th November 2024 with an objective to highlight the importance of literacy and India's commitment to education.

Prof (Dr.) Sandip Kumar, Associate Professor in CIE, Delhi University was the esteemed guest for the day. He highlighted the importance of National Education Day and emphasized how equitable access to quality education can serve as a catalyst for national growth. He gave a brief introduction about the education system in India. He spoke about the life story of Abul Kalam Azad, the first Minister for Education in India. Then he pointed out how the COVID-19 pandemic had compelled the global and abrupt conversion of conventional face-to-face instruction to the online format in many educational institutions. Urgent and careful planning is needed to mitigate the negative effects of the pandemic on engineering education, an education that has been traditionally content-centered, hands-on and design-oriented.

He covered key topics that included:

- The integration of technology to expand access to quality education.
- Addressing disparities in education across urban and rural areas.
- Developing critical thinking and soft skills in the curriculum to prepare students for future challenges.

He highlighted the importance of collaborative efforts between the government, private sector, and communities to ensure equitable education for all. This celebration of Indian National Education Day reaffirmed GIBS's commitment to fostering an environment where learning is accessible, inclusive, and transformative.
