19TH NOVEMBER 2024 (TUESDAY)**



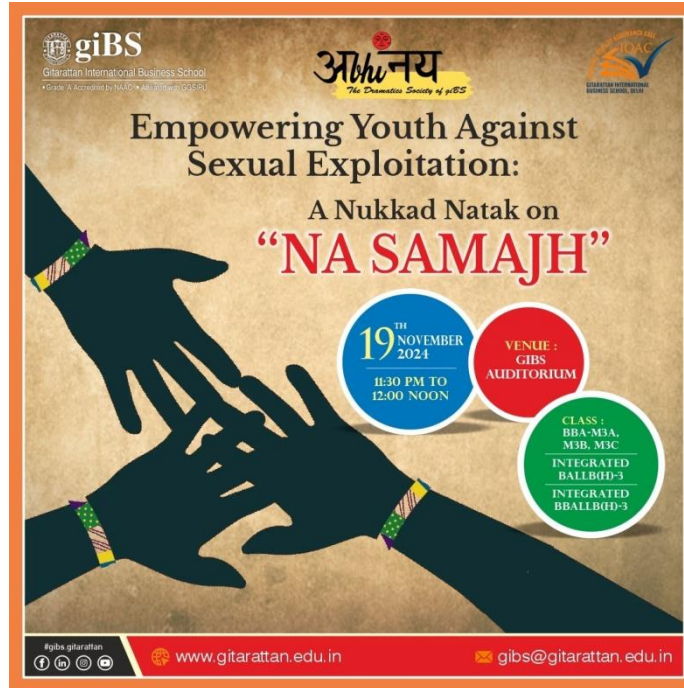
In response to Notice No. F./IPU/DSW/19/972 dated 6.11.24 issued by GGSIPU, colleges were required to create awareness on critical issues such as cyber bullying, cyber pornography, drug abuse, child bullying, human trafficking, online predators, sexting, and sexual exploitation. In accordance to the notice, our institute organized a powerful and thought-provoking *Nukkad Natak* titled "**NAA SAMAJH**" to address the issue of sexual exploitation and its devastating impact on individuals and society on 19th November 2024 (Tuesday).

The performance took place in the auditorium, transforming it into a hub of learning and engagement. Students from *The Abhinay Club* took center stage, delivering a gripping narrative that exposed the harsh realities of exploitation and emphasized the importance of awareness, vigilance, and action. The theme of "*NAA SAMAJH*" focused on bridging the gap between ignorance and understanding, inspiring the audience to recognize and tackle these challenges with determination. The event aimed to educate and sensitize the public about critical issues affecting children, particularly girl children, and to encourage proactive measures to address them.

The play opened with a poignant portrayal of the daily struggles faced by girl children in a patriarchal society. Scenes depicted instances of abuse, societal expectations to conform, and negligence towards the holistic development of children. The actors effectively used powerful dialogues, expressions, and body language to evoke emotions and deliver a strong message. A key segment focused on educating the audience about reporting mechanisms such as the use of Child Helpline lodging complaints with authorities, and the importance of community involvement to ensure the safety of children.

The event concluded with the speech by our Hon'ble Director, Prof. (Dr.) Vikas Nath, who highlighted the critical need to address these issues in today's digital and interconnected world. His speech set the tone for the day, encouraging everyone to adopt a proactive approach toward combating exploitation.
