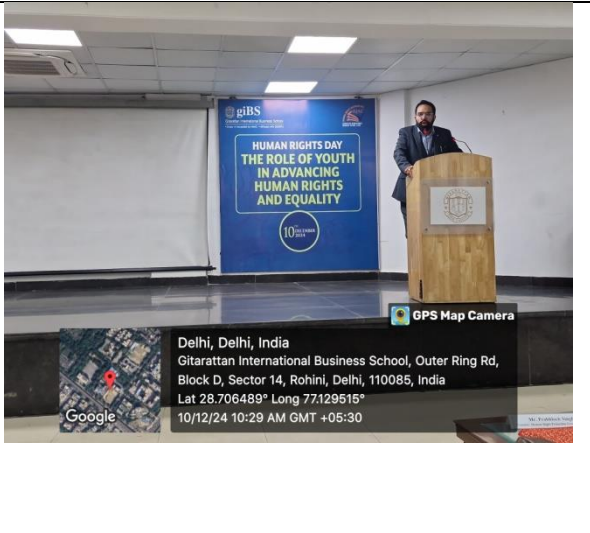


**HUMAN RIGHTS DAY**

On 10<sup>th</sup> December 2024, the Centre for legal studies of GIBS organized an impactful event titled “ **Advancing Human Rights & Equality**” to celebrate Human Rights Day, held in the Institute’s auditorium. The event was attended by students of Integrated BALLB and Integrated BBALLB 1<sup>st</sup> Semester (all sections), faculty, and distinguished guests, all coming together to raise awareness about the importance of human rights in today’s world. The program began with an insightful introduction to Human Rights Day, highlighting its global significance and the need for ongoing efforts to protect the rights of individuals worldwide. 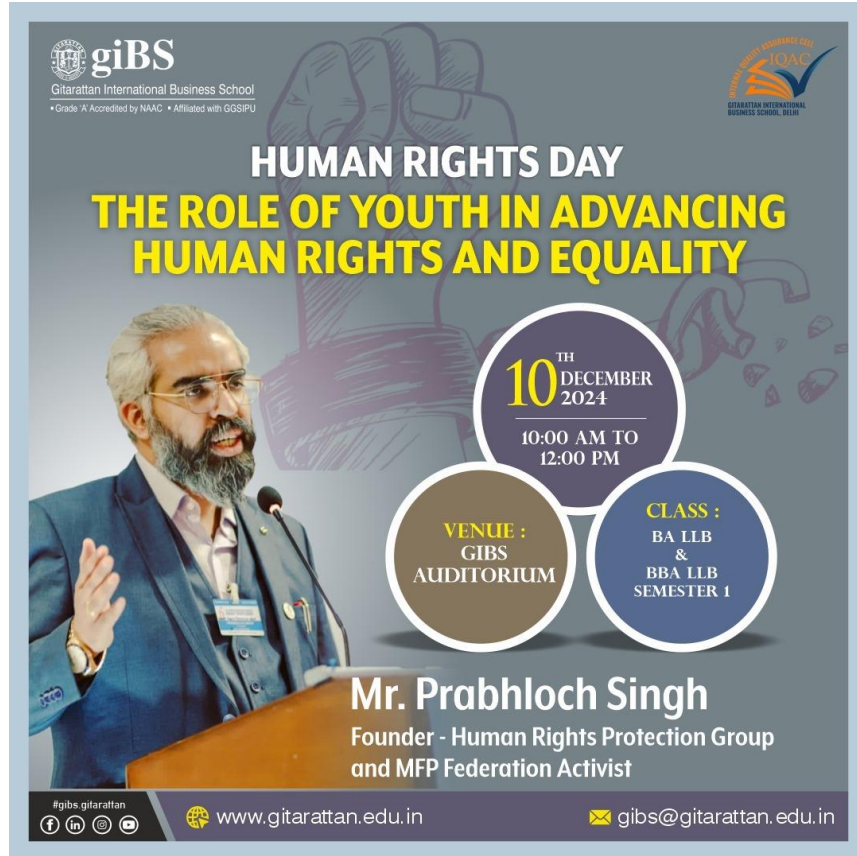
