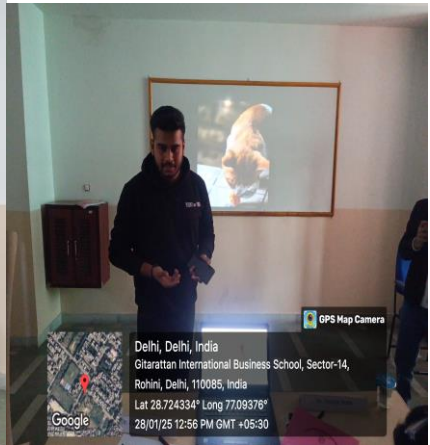


CULTURAL DAY
