

BEYOND THE COURTROOM - MASTERING MODERN DISPUTE RESOLUTION 6TH MARCH 2025 (THURSDAY)

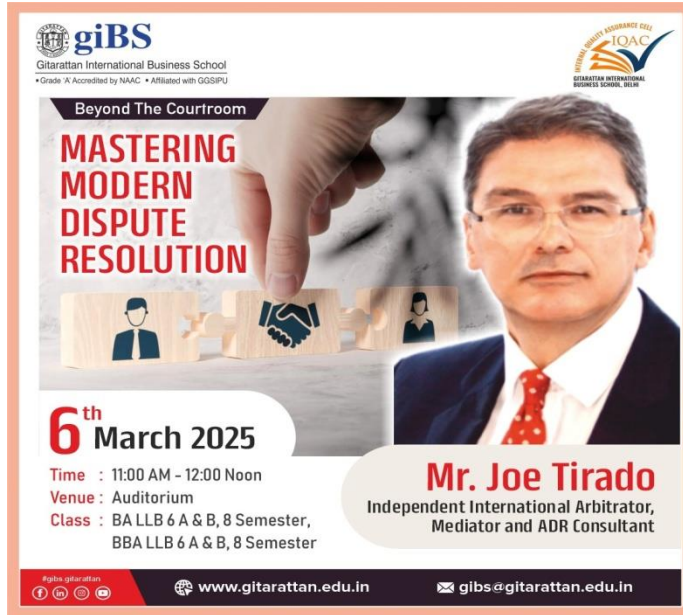
