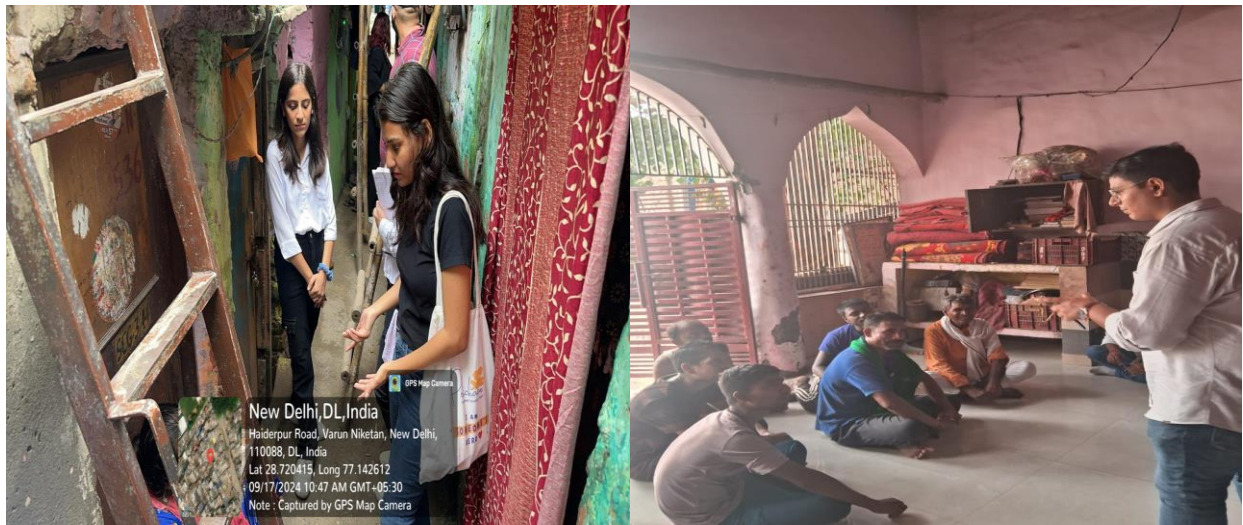


ADULT LITERACY CAMP

(UNDER NSS 10-DAYS SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL CAMP)

17th SEPTEMBER 2024 (TUESDAY)



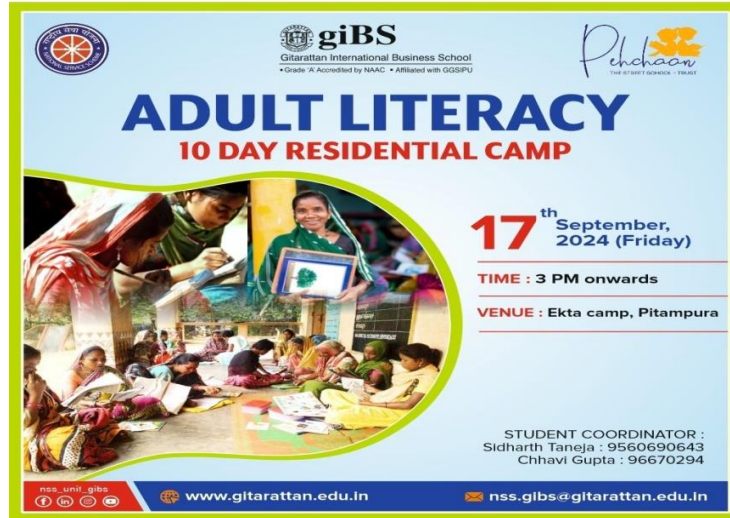
As part of the community outreach initiative aimed at promoting adult literacy, a one-day **Adult Literacy Camp** was organized by the NSS Unit of GIBS organized a Session on Adult Literacy in collaboration with the Pehchaan Street School (NGO) in our adopted village Ekta camp, Pitampura on 17th September 2024. The camp was facilitated by a team of NSS volunteers of GIBS and social workers from Pehchaan Street School who devoted their time to engaging the participants in practical and interactive learning sessions.

The event was conducted on day one of the 10 Days special camp with the main motto to make the adults of the village aware about the importance of education in one's life and enable them to gain confidence in managing daily tasks and interacting with official processes. The camp was attended by approximately 30 adults from the community, most of whom had little to no formal education. The camp was structured into two main sessions: Basic Mathematics and Learning to Write Signatures. The event lasted from 3:00 pm-5:30 pm. NSS volunteers divided their duties managed all the people and maintained discipline. The villagers were taught how to do signatures, solve basic profit and loss, multiplication, addition and subtraction which would help them to solve their daily problems. The session was conducted in a simple, easy-to-understand manner, with the use of local language to ensure all participants could follow along. The second session was dedicated to teaching participants how to write their signatures, a skill essential for many official purposes, such as opening a bank account, signing contracts, or receiving government benefits.

The camp proved to be an encouraging and beneficial experience for the participants. By the end of the day, most participants had grasped basic math concepts and were able to perform simple calculations. Additionally, nearly all participants succeeded in writing their signatures.

The participants expressed their appreciation for the opportunity to learn, with many sharing that they felt more empowered to handle everyday tasks like shopping and managing money. Some expressed interest in continuing their learning, highlighting the need for more regular literacy programs in their community.
