Gitarattan International Business School organized "Zenith-2025," the 18th Annual Cultural Fest of GIBS, on 21st February 2025 at The Sovereign School, Sec 24, Rohini. The event commenced with a grand inaugural ceremony, where honorable dignitaries, including Vice Chairman Shri Anirudh Jindal, Dean Ms. Prachi Jindal and Director Dr. Prof. Vikas Nath, graced the occasion. The ceremonial lamp lighting and an enchanting Ganesh Vandana performance by the Mudra dance society marked the beginning of the celebration.



Zenith 2025 featured 12 cultural competitions, the 4th Annual Art & Photography Exhibition "Aalekhya," and a grand Star Night with the Punjabi duo Jassie Gill & Babbal Rai. This year,

the fest witnessed record participation, with 850 participants from 135 colleges across Delhi NCR. The event was captured by our official photography partner Delhi College of Photography.

Soon after the main inaugural ceremony, the art and photography exhibition was inaugurated by esteemed guest Mr. Kumar.S, Senior Faculty of Graphic Design & Photography at Artography Studio and Dean Ms Prachi Jindal. Aalekhya was a resounding success, showcasing the immense talent of 100 enthusiastic artists and photographers. The event provided a platform for creative expression and artistic appreciation, attracting a diverse audience including students, art enthusiasts, and budding photographers. The exhibition featured breathtaking paintings, photographs, and creative artworks, offering a platform for artists to showcase their imagination. Mr. Kumar judged the best artwork and best photograph display amongst all. Mr. Anmol commended the participants for their creativity, technical skills, and storytelling through visuals.

- **One with the Beat: Western Dance (Solo)** – Individual dancers mesmerized the audience with styles like hip-hop, jazz, and freestyle, displaying creativity and agility.

- **Rangotsav: Rangoli Making** – Artists created vibrant and intricate rangoli designs, blending tradition with creativity using colors, flowers, and innovative materials. The theme of the event was “Geometric Symmetry- Kaleidoscope- Inspired Patterns”.
- **Through the Lens: Photography Competition** – Aspiring photographers captured powerful stories and emotions, showcasing technical expertise and artistic perspectives. The theme of the event was “Moments in Motion”-Capture dynamic actions frozen in time, showcasing energy and movement through creative techniques like motion blur or slow shutter speed.
