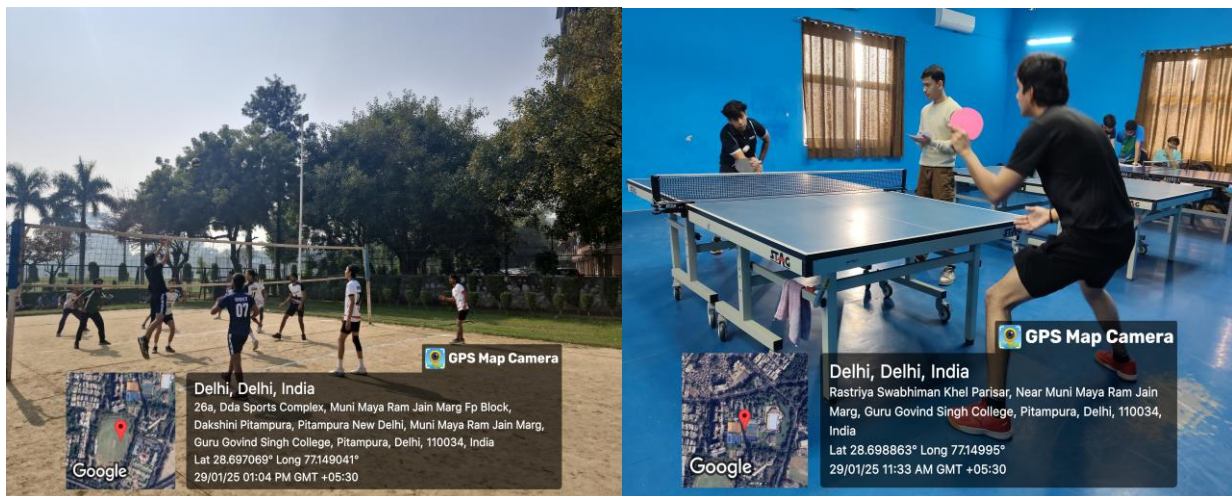
29TH & 30TH JANUARY 2025 (WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY)



The Sports Club of GIBS, *Lakshya*, successfully organized its Annual Inter-College Sports Meet – LAKSHAY 2025 on the 29th and 30th of January 2025 at Rashtriya Swabhiman Khel Parisar, Pitampura, Delhi – 110034.

The event was inaugurated by Director Prof. (Dr.) Vikas Nath, who marked the commencement with the traditional Lighting of the Lamp and performed the Coin Toss for the inaugural cricket match. LAKSHAY 2025 featured six major sports events, witnessing enthusiastic participation from students across various colleges. The sports events were Cricket, Tug of War, Basketball, Volleyball, Table Tennis & Badminton. In total, over 550 participants and coordinators contributed to the success of LAKSHAY 2025, making it a grand and competitive sporting event. The sports meet served as a platform for students to showcase their skills, teamwork, and sportsmanship, reinforcing the club's commitment to promoting athletic excellence and healthy competition.

On day one, all students were duly registered with the registration team and provided with refreshments before the commencement of events. The matches were officiated by referees, who closely monitored and guided players in scoring and gameplay across all events.





Tug of War
