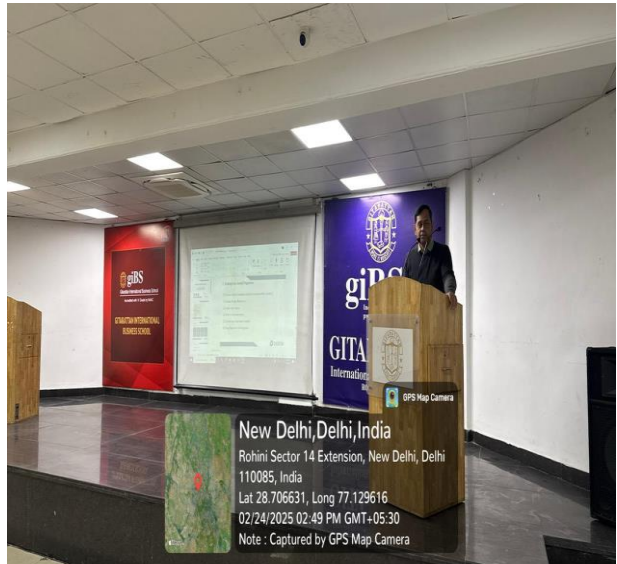


NDLI WORKSHOP ON "UNDERSTANDING PLAGIARISM" 24TH FEBRUARY 2025 (MONDAY)

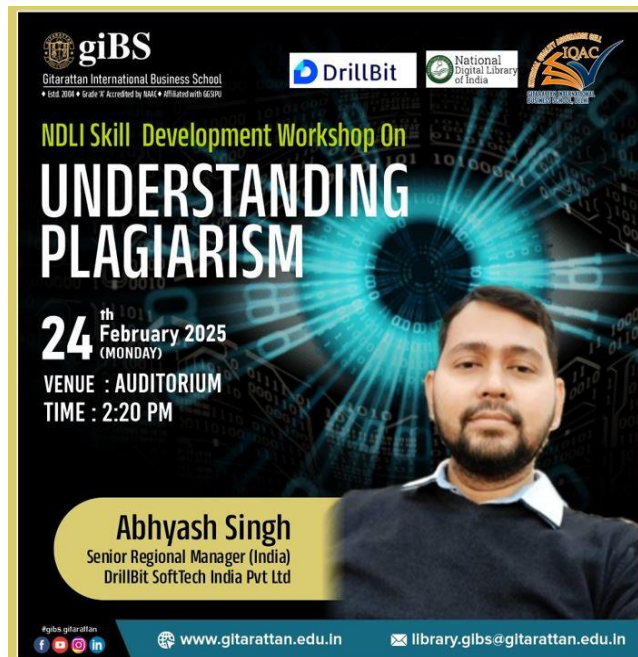

Participants were also introduced to strategies like paraphrasing, summarization, and proper attribution to maintain originality in their work.

The workshop included an interactive Q&A session where students and faculty members raised queries regarding plagiarism detection, the use of AI tools in academic writing, and best practices for ethical research. The speaker addressed their concerns and provided practical solutions to avoid plagiarism in assignments, research papers, and dissertations.
